Bly Becomes First County Town To Top Fund Drive

The public spirited community of Bly is the first county community to top its United Fund-Red Cross campaign target this year, according to Tom McCarry, associate drive chairman under Noel Flynn.

Bly, under its co-chairmen Mrs. Dave Campbell and Mrs. William Hatzl, Tuesday reported they had reached their goal of \$750. McCarry said organization for the campaign in Merrill was formulated at a meeting Monday noon under William Kurtz, principal of the Merrill Elementary School who is heading the drive in that community.

Present for the meeting were 12 key organizers, Mrs. Murel Long, Mrs. Roy Beasley, Mrs. Jack Fleck, Mrs. Paul Lewis, Mrs. Melvin Bowman, Wilbur Haskins, Mrs. Dwight Eagle, Mrs. Jack Hammond, Mrs. Don Crawford, Mrs. John Chase, Louis Stewart and Mrs. Lawson Kandra.

The volunteers blocked off areas and assigned workers to their districts of responsibility. Campaigns are also getting underway in the other county communities, McCarry said.

David Schneider, \$1,600 with \$800 reported; Beatty, \$100; Wood River Valley under Myrtle Wimer, Elizabeth Loosley and Mrs. Wilbur Hescoek, \$1,200 with \$26.45 reported; Gilchrist - Crescent under O. R. Sample, \$3,000 with \$1,200 reported; Chemult under Eugene Epperson and Lou Williams, \$250 with \$50 reported.

County south: Poe Valley-Olene-Pine Grove under Mrs. Wilbur Reiling, \$1,000 with \$174 reported; Henley-Midland under Irwin Brower and Mrs. Fred Crapo, \$1,700; Keno-Worden under Mrs. James Kerns Jr., \$750; Bonanza-Dairy under Mrs. Robert Schmor, \$1,000; Merrill under William Kurtz, \$3,025; Malin under Charles Hale assisted by Hazel Kalina and Mrs. Ed Stastny, 3,000 and Langell Valley, \$500.

McCarry said the figures are complete following the Friday audit. More contributions have been received, he said, but have not been processed through the fund office.

Lakeview Church Named Winner

CORVALLIS — The Oregon Council of Churches Monday night presented cash awards to 20 rural churches for improvement of buildings and grounds and for service given to communities. The awards were made at the annual meeting of the Town and Country Church Conference here. Dillard-Sinon Methodist Church was first in the open-country classification. Rockwood Church of God near Portland was first in the group serving an area of less than 2,500 and Our Saviour Lutheran Church, Oswego, led the 2,500 population class. Bethel Presbyterian Church near Woodburn was among churches receiving awards in the open-country division. Lakeview Methodist Church was a winner in the over 2,500 division.

Obscene Book Ban Studied

WASHINGTON (UP)—The Supreme Court today called up a challenge to Michigan's law banning sale of books containing allegedly obscene language or descriptions tending to corrupt youth. The case was the first to come before William J. Brennan Jr., as a Supreme Court justice. Brennan was scheduled to be sworn in today and take his place on the bench, succeeding Justice Sherman Minton. The obscene book case started with the arrest by Detroit police of Alfred E. Butler on charges that he sold a copy of "The Devil Rides Outside" by John H. Griffin. The book — published by Pocket Books Inc. of New York and contains intimate sex details. The police department said the language tends to corrupt the morals of youth. Butler argued among other things that the statute under which he was charged denies freedom of the press because it allows judging part of a book without consideration of its literary merit as a whole.
