Ullman Blasts Farm Policies

Klamath County is being hurt by Republican farm, money and power policies, according to Al Ullman, Democratic candidate for Congress. He addressed the County Democratic committee here Monday night.

"I will work to bring this country the prosperity it deserves," Ullman told the group.

"Tight money, high-interest policies are shutting down the home building business all over the country and putting a serious crimp in the lumber industry," Ullman said. "Jobs and payrolls are at stake, plus the investment of our mill operators. This is directly the result of Republican 'Wall Street' policies."

Ullman told the group that small businesses were also caught in

the bind of tight money. "You small businessmen know what I am talking about," he said.

The congressional candidate cited figures showing that farmers were paying 44 per cent more in interest payments today than they were in 1952. "We could build Hells Canyon Dam on the extra interest veterans are paying on their 1954 and 1955 loans as a result of Republican action," he said.

"We need action now to force down interest rates and to curb the growing pressure of monopoly control on small businesses. We need to restore farm income now," Ullman said. "You won't get any help from my opponent who has gone down the line with the unsound policies of Secretaries Benson, McKay and Humphrey."

Ullman spent the day meeting people in Klamath Falls. "I like people. I want to meet everyone I can and find out about their problems," Ullman said.

He is accompanied here by Mrs. Ullman. After a rigorous schedule in Central Oregon the next few days they will return here for meetings Friday afternoon, Friday evening and Saturday they will spend at the Potato Festival at Merrill.
