Navy Launches New Deepfreeze

CHRISTCHURCH, New Zealand (AP) — Aided by the thrust of six jets, a heavily laden Skymaster

took off from Harewood Airport at 6 p.m. Tuesday to launch the second of the U.S. Navy's antarctic Operation Deepfreeze projects.

Cmdr. Henry P. Jorda of Quonset, R.I., was at the controls as the four-engine plane roared southward toward McMurdo sound, on the Ross Sea 2250 miles away.

Cargo for the 166 Americans who have spent the winter in two U.S. bases there included a 450-pound load of letters, their first mail since last March.

The flight, under slight headwinds, is expected to take about 13 hours. The next phase of Deepfreeze will be the flying in of four giant Globemasters flying top priority equipment to McMurdo.

'Open Skies' Plan Tested

ROME (AP) — Italy after five days of aerial snooping says it has proved President Eisenhower's "open skies" military inspection plan works.

"The results of the practical demonstrations prove aerial reconnaissance is an efficacious method of checking on military preparations," the Italian Defense Ministry announced.

The exercise was an all-Italian operation with no help from NATO or the Western Allies. For five days 50 jets and reconnaissance planes prowled over central Italy taking before-and-after photographs of simulated military preparations.

The pilots did not know where to look for the mock installations, and the experts who studied the photographs were not told what sort of buildup was being made.

Under the "open skies" plan, a nation's planes would be allowed by agreement to fly over another's territory to check on "warlike activity or preparations." The plan first was sponsored by President Eisenhower at the Geneva summit meeting in July 1955, as a first step toward world disarmament.

Geological Survey staff; O. M. Browne, Boise, regional project development engineer for the Bureau of Reclamation; and Doren E. Woodward, supervisor of river basin studies for the Fish and Wildlife Service office at Portland.
