Passage of the amendment would allow the state to continue receiving these gifts which have done so much to aid the state institutions in the past. Remember, Proposition Two is the ballot title of this non-partisan measure on the November 6 general election ballot.

Marine Hero Found Guilty In Special Court Martial

PARRIS ISLAND, S. C. (AP) — A Marine Medal of Honor winner who held blazing hot machine guns to fight off a Red Chinese attack has been convicted by special court-martial here. Sgt. Alford Lee McLaughlin was sentenced to three months hard labor, reduction to private and a \$120 fine.

The unpublicized court-martial was held on this sprawling recruit training center yesterday. McLaughlin pleaded guilty to drunkenness and unauthorized absence and was found guilty of disrespect to a superior officer and to a superior noncommissioned officer. The 28-year-old native of Leeds, Ala., was court-martialed for an episode last March at Rome, Ga., where he was stationed with a Marine reserve outfit.
