WMU Leader Plans Speech

Mrs. R. L. Sessions of the convention will be 1:30 to 4 p.m. and from 7 to 9 p.m. on Monday and 9:30 a.m. to 12 noon and again from 7-9 p.m. on Tuesday.

The public is invited to attend any or all sessions of the convention in the church auditorium.

UAL Switches Plane Types

United Air Lines flights in and out of Klamath Falls will switch from DC-3 to Convair operation October 23, it was announced today by S. M. Randolph, station ground services manager.

The revised schedules cut flight time to San Francisco by 45 minutes and to Seattle by 35 minutes. A southbound 44-passenger Convair will depart from here at 2:45 p.m., reaching the Golden Gate City at 5 p.m. A return trip leaving San Francisco at 11:15 a.m. will arrive here at 1:30 p.m.

Leaving Klamath Falls at 1:45 p.m., a northbound Convair will reach Portland at 3:45 p.m. and Seattle-Tacoma at 5 p.m. Return service will leave Seattle at 11:10 a.m., with arrival here at 2:30 p.m.

The twin-engine Convair cruises at 270 miles per hour, compared to the 180-mile-an-hour speed of the DC-3; has a pressurized cabin and carries 4,100 pounds of air mail, express and freight.

Merrill City Vote Slated

MERRILL — All offices of the city of Merrill are to be voted on at an important city election held on Tuesday, November 6. Polling place is at the Merrill Community Hall.

To be filled for a two-year term is the office of mayor. Two councilmen for a two year term each and two councilmen for four year term each are to be voted into office.

The offices of city recorder and police judge must also be elected this year. Each term is for two years.

Two charter amendments to be voted on by the Merrill electors are:

1. To provide for the combining of the office of city treasurer and city recorder.

2. To provide for officers elected by the electors of the city at large to take office the first day of the year following election.

secretary of state at \$1,500 annually, the state treasurer at \$900 and supreme court justices at \$2,000.

The repeal of this obsolete section of the constitution will not have any practical effect because the constitutional section outlining the pay of these state officers has been disregarded since 1905. Legislative action has changed the salaries of these officers nine times. The governor now received \$15,000, the secretary of state and state treasurer \$10,000 and supreme court justices \$12,000. The Legislature voted unanimously to refer the amendment to the people.

The action to repeal this "outmoded" section of the constitution is designed merely to clarify the constitution and to give the Legislature the legal right to adjust the salaries of these state officials as it sees fit.

The only argument against the amendment has been that another

provision in the same section of the constitution prohibiting officers from receiving fees in addition to their salaries is. Oregon law. The Legislature took the action to refer this amendment to the

people for the purpose of eliminating those portions of the constitution which are outmoded, unnecessary, and cause confusion. Other obsolete sections of the constitution will be referred to the people from time to time in this effort to modernize archaic sections of the statutes. This Proposition Three is another non-partisan measure on the general election ballot.

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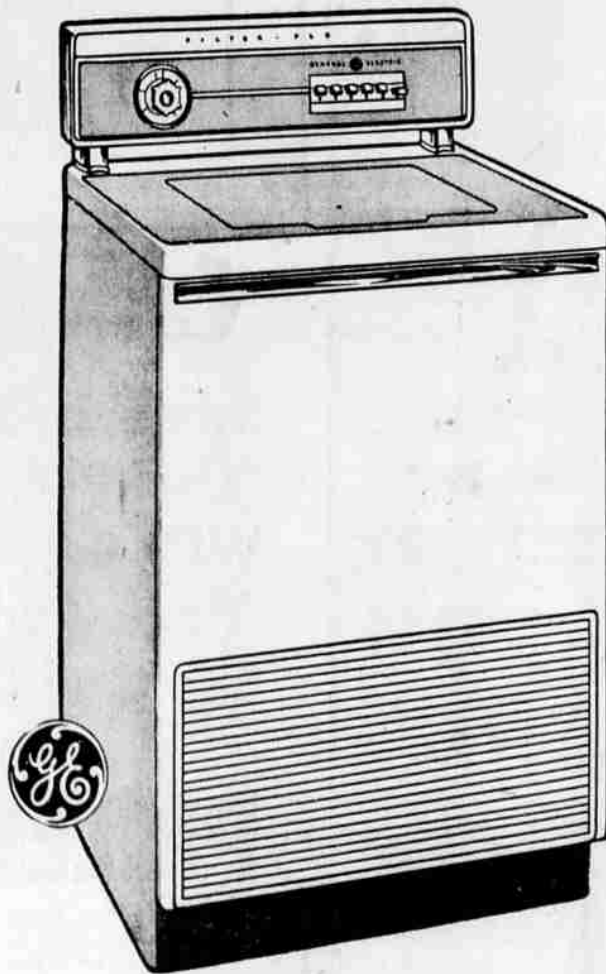
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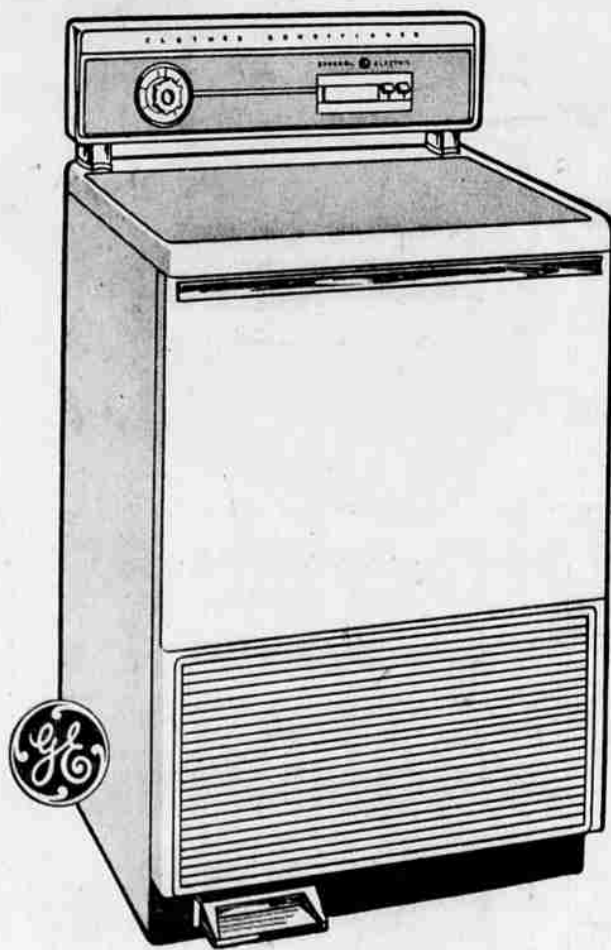
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
