Estes Speaks On Fallout

DETROIT (AP) — Sen. Estes Kefauver said today it was not "Democratic politicians" but nuclear scientists who first revealed the dangers of radioactive H-bomb fallout.

The Democratic vice-presidential candidate made his statement in reply to Sen. Hickenlooper (Iowa), who was quoted in news accounts as saying a "clean" H-bomb has been developed. Hickenlooper said he wanted to "straighten out" some "Democratic politicians."

"I presume he is talking about Adlai Stevenson and me," Kefauver said.

"I would say that we 'Democratic politicians' wouldn't have known a thing about the deadly dangers of H-bomb fallout if we hadn't been told by nuclear scientists," Kefauver stated.

He quoted physicist Dr. Ralph Lapp, Nobel laureate Linus Pauling and Dr. David Hill to back up his contention, and added:

"This 'clean bomb' nonsense reminds me of the story of the crazy assassin who tried to reassure each victim just before shooting him that he need have no fear of infection, for each bullet had been washed in good soap and water."
