BLUE CHEESE DIP

Cut 1 pound of blue cheese into small pieces. Place in bowl with 3/4 cup lemon juice, 2 teaspoons dry mustard and 1/4 teaspoon pepper. Beat with electric mixer, using low speed until light and smooth. Add 1 pound cream cheese and 1-1/2 cups cottage cheese and onion salt to taste. Beat again until consistency of whipped cream. Chill until ready to serve. Store in tightly closed jar and it will keep for several weeks. Correct seasonings just before removing from bowl and add more pepper, salt or onion salt. Recipe makes one quart.

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Long Line Look

When Charles of the Ritz Paris Salon introduced the Long Line hair styles during the fall fashion showings in France it set off a whole new trend in elegant styling that is just now catching on here in America in time for winter formals and resort wear. Not in years have we seen hair so distinctly feminine and exquisitely groomed. With the length no

longer than medium, it's draped and puffed like supple fabric into softly waved full lines to give quiet elegance to the entire appearance.

For evenings at the opera this Long Line style can be draped completely over to one side of the head and here fastened into a puffed, looped coil to give an interesting profile effect. This Long Line takes another dramatic turn when it's softly scooped all the way back into an "elongated" full-

ness at the crown. Still other ways the Long Line style may be worn for evening is the sleek, full bouffant that seems to make the features more diminutive and dainty than ever. The fullness begins at the temples and bellows out just below ear level where the ends roll under into puffed width.

Ropes of pearls and brilliant hair ornaments may be placed in the hair to outline the sweeping and elaborateness of these formal coiffures whenever occa-

Butterscotch Drops

Cookies always express hospitality. Walnut Butterscotch Drops not only make folks feel welcome but these cookies receive a warm welcome themselves! These little drops are deliciously crunchy with generous chunks of California walnuts; butterscotchy in flavor with brown sugar and butter. Recipe makes 3 1/2 dozen and is easily doubled.

BUTTERSCOTCH DROPS

1/2 cup soft butter or margarine
1 1/4 cups brown sugar (packed)
1 egg
2-3 cup sifted all-purpose flour
1 teaspoon baking powder
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon vanilla
1 1/4 cups coarsely chopped California walnuts

Cream butter and sugar together. Add egg and beat well. Sift flour with baking powder and salt. Blend into first mixture. Blend in

vanilla and walnuts. Drop by teaspoonfuls onto greased baking sheet. Bake in moderately slow oven (325 degrees) about 15 minutes. Allow to stand a minute or rack using broad spatula. Makes about 3 1/2 dozen cookies.
