Central Oregon Demos Optimistic This Year

PRINEVILLE (AP) — The power issue and a large number of former Oklahomans are combining to make the Democrats optimistic in Central Oregon.

So is a minor business recession caused by virtual completion of the dam at The Dalles and by lay-off of lumber workers.

Here, as in other parts of the state, the chief interest is in the bitter struggle between Sen. Wayne Morse and his Republican opponent, Doug McKay.

Key figures in both parties and political writers agree that Morse will carry this heavily Democratic area.

Rep. Sam Coon, Republican, and Democrat Al Ullman, both of

Baker, are in a close race, too, that promises to be tighter than that of two years ago when Coon defeated Ullman 43,731 to 38,475.

As in other sections, there seem to be many voters who are supporting President Eisenhower and Morse.

In a stop at The Dalles, several persons questioned said they would vote for Morse because of his support of a federally constructed John Day Dam. More dam work would help business at The Dalles.

In Prineville, polls show that Eisenhower and Morse will win. This is considered significant by some because Crook County, of which Prineville is the county seat, always has supported the winner for president.

E. A. Donnelly, Prineville publisher who conducts local polls, says "in the past 30 days, there has been a tremendous sweep to-

ward Morse throughout Central Oregon." Donnelly has maintained a neutral editorial position.

He says the lumber mills have laid off about 10 per cent of their workers, who were earning overtime pay 18 months ago. There are many former Oklahomans in these mills, and they have brought their Democratic voting habits with them.

Donnelly, along with other observers in the area, was sharply critical of Republican efforts.

"The Democrats," he said, "are ringing doorbells, and working like mad. The Republicans aren't doing much of anything. They act like they were made to rule, and that they'll get the votes by living right."

Ullman went to a big mill, Donnelly said, and asked permission to talk to the workers, but the manager told him it was against the rules. A week later, Coon

made the same request, and was personally escorted through the mill by the manager. Donnelly said the mill workers were angered.

In Hood River, a lawyer, who is a lifelong Republican, said he was voting the straight Democratic ticket because the "liberals have no chance in the Republican Party."

Of the 18 Eastern Oregon counties, only five give the Republicans a registration lead. They are

Gilliam, Grant, Malheur, Morrow and Sherman.

The Democrats have outgained the Republicans in almost every Central Oregon county since the primary last May.

Some observers in the Central Oregon counties believe a considerable number of supporters of Phil Hitchcock, whom McKay beat in the primary, are favoring Morse.

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Statute Allows Peace Agency

UNITED NATIONS, N.Y. (AP) — The 82-nation International Atomic Agency has adopted by unanimous vote a statute setting up a world atoms-for-peace agency.

The ballot Tuesday came after nearly two years of negotiation begun when President Eisenhower proposed to the U.N. General Assembly that a world atomic agency be set up.

The statute establishing the agency in Vienna will be opened for signature Friday.

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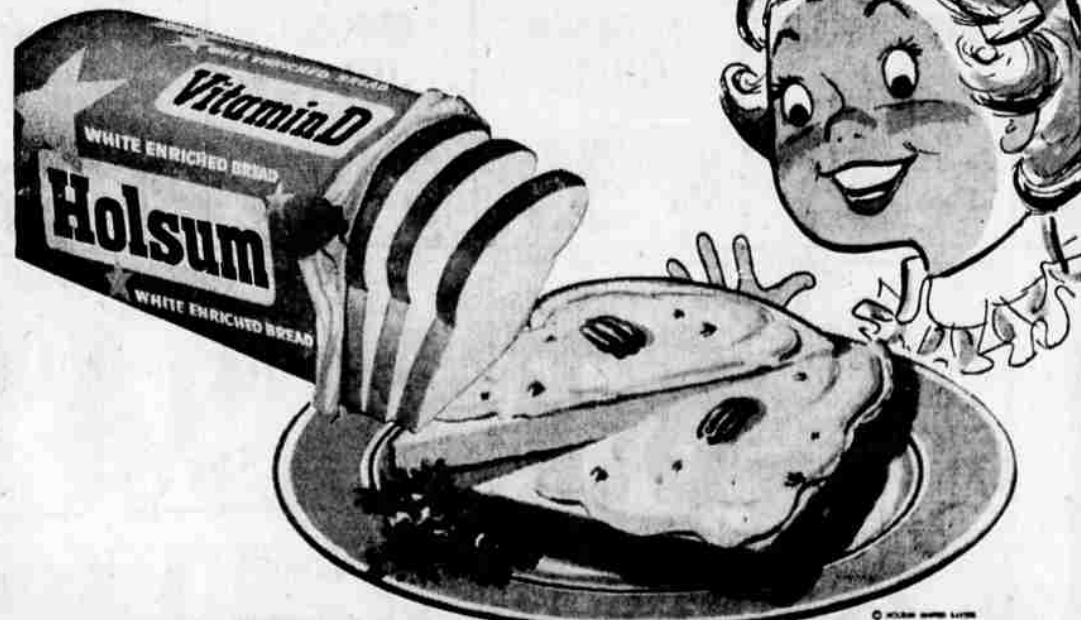
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
