Here's Your Candidate

Harry D. Boivin is the Democratic party candidate for state senator for the Eighteenth District, Klamath County. Boivin is 32 years old, was born in Ashland, and moved with his family to Klamath Falls when he was two years old.

His elementary and high school education was completed in Klamath Falls. He took his legal degree from Santa Clara University, and did post graduate work at the University of California.

He is now completing his first term in the state Senate, and prior to that served five terms in the state Legislature. He was speaker of the House from 1937-39. During his legislative and senatorial terms he has been a member of numerous state boards and committees. He is a lawyer and businessman by profession.

"I believe that Klamath County fared well during the last session of the state Legislature," Boivin said, "and I feel that if I am reelected my legislative and senatorial experience will be of great value to the people of the county."

DAL REED

Here's Your Candidate

Dal Reed is a Republican candidate for the office of sheriff of Klamath County. He is a native of Washington and has been a resident of Klamath County for the past 14 years. He is a high school graduate of Oregon schools.

His police work background consists of seven and a half years with the state police of Klamath County, two years as chief criminal deputy with the Klamath County sheriff's force, and one and a half years as Merrill chief of police. He currently occupies the latter post.

He is married and the father of four children.

As a candidate for the office Reed states the following:

"I favor the keeping of permanent records in the sheriff's office, with copies to be furnished the state, county and city law enforcement officials. An officer would also be available at all times to assist state, city, and other county agencies when requested to do so.

"I will, if elected, make it mandatory that sheriff's officers attend local or nearby FBI or state sponsored police schools, and the sheriff's office would sponsor schools on law and law enforcement to be attended by the deputies.

"The juvenile office would be assisted by the sheriff's force on request, and I would insure that all individuals would be given impartial consideration."

He was dead on arrival at a hospital with a .38 caliber bullet wound in the chest. The mother said the boys must have taken the revolver from a chest where she had placed it. John said Larry put the pistol to his own chest and pulled the trigger.

Liner Captain Collapses During Doria Hearing

NEW YORK (UPI)—A junior officer of the Stockholm substitutes today for Capt. Gunnar Nordenson who collapsed Wednesday during a cross-examination of the collision of his ship with the Andrea Doria which took 30 lives.

Nordenson, 63, suffered a cerebral spasm near the end of his third day on the witness stand and was taken to St. Luke's Hospital for observation.

The ruddy old sea dog said his "brain just stopped working" when he collapsed and was unable to go on with testimony. His physician called his illness a "period of lack of concentration."

Illness has now struck both captains of the vessels which collided in waters south of Nantucket lightship on the night of July 25.

EMOTIONAL SHOCK

Capt. Piero Calamai was hospitalized for "emotional shock" for nine days shortly after the crash and rescue at sea. He appeared on the witness stand during nearly two weeks of arduous cross-examination as a shaken and brooding man.

"I had loved the sea all my life," he said. "Now I hate it."

Congress Eyes Sin Cost Raise

WASHINGTON (UPI)—Congress is taking steps to raise the cost of living in sin.

Congressional tax experts disclosed that they are considering increasing taxes on bachelor playboys who set up housekeeping with women to whom they are not married.

As matters stand now, the wayward male can claim an income tax exemption amounting to \$600 by declaring that his mistress is a "dependent of his household."

But a House Ways and Means subcommittee indicated Wednesday that the days of tax relief for illicit love may be numbered.

The subcommittee announced it is considering legislation that would bar a taxpayer from counting as a member of his household any individual with whom his relationship at any time during the taxable year is in "violation of local law."

Acid Perils Colorado City

DURANGO, Colo. (UPI)—A large tank truck plunged off a bridge south of Durango Wednesday, dumping 3,000 gallons of sulphuric acid into the Animas River which furnishes water to three towns.

Health officials sent out warnings to the communities against using river water and apparently the danger ended early today when the deadly acid passed the towns in diluted form.

Dr. George Moore, director of the San Juan Basin health unit at Durango, said dead fish were reported all along the river bank and warned residents against eating them.

District health officer Warren Rasmussen ordered water intakes shut off at Farmington, Aztec and Shiprock, N.M.—three towns which get water from the San Juan River below the point where the Animas empties into it.

He instructed water supply personnel at the three New Mexico towns to keep the intakes shut from eight to 10 hours. He said by that time the water should not be dangerous but tests would be conducted to make sure the water was not contaminated.

Durango residents escaped exposure because the acid spilled into the river below the water plant.

LESSON

LONG BEACH, Calif. (AP) — A father was arrested after teaching his 9-year-old son what he said was "a lesson in cleanliness" with a scrub brush, police reported. Itoy Wise, 31, was booked on suspicion of unjustifiable punishment of a child. Juvenile officers said the boy, George, suffered deep scratches on the face and back.
