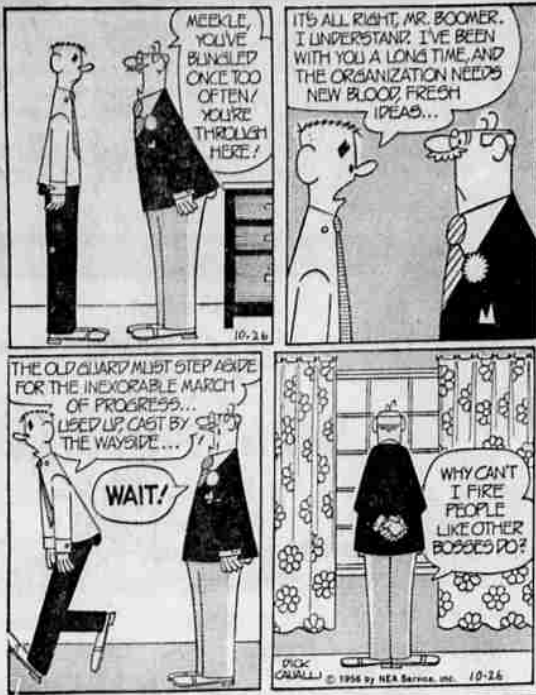

California Politics

Editor's Note: This is the third of a series of articles discussing the measures found on the California State Ballot for November 6. Information and recommendations are taken from many state organizations, a few of which are: Farm Bureau, PTA and Teachers Association, County Supervisors Association, Federation of Labor, Taxpayers Association, League of Women Voters, Agricultural Council, and California Chamber of Commerce.

Proposition No. 10. This Senate Constitutional Amendment would permit the Legislature to authorize the employment of private architects and engineers on a contract basis to do work which the obtainable staff of a state agency is unable to perform within the time the public interest requires such work to be done. A safeguard of the Civil Service principle is included which requires agreement by two principal state officials that the above situation exists.

Proponents claim that such contract employment of private architects and engineers at times of peak loads permits freeing of the payroll on completion of the contract. Over staffing during times of normal load could be avoided, and with the shortages of architects and engineers, available of such personnel in private firms would permit completion of projects which otherwise would be delayed.

Opponents state that this contributes to the breakdown of the Civil Service and there is no assurance that overall state costs would be less by such an expediency.

All groups studied recommended a Yes Vote on No. 10.

Proposition No. 11 is an Assembly Constitutional Amendment which extends time for board of freeholders to prepare proposed county charters from six months to one year. The reason being that the growing complexity of county government necessitates longer periods of consideration for framing county charters. There is no organized opposition. Vote Yes on No. 11.

Proposition No. 12 is a Senate Constitutional Amendment which changes the maximum time of state bond retirement from 75 to 50 years. Most groups studied argued that the 75 year maturity is unfair to future generations and most present practices now redeem bonds in 25 to 40 years. The Legislature should have authority to reduce the amount of indebtedness of any bond issue. They recommend a Yes vote but the Federation of Labor says to vote No on No. 12.

Proposition No. 13. This act, if approved by the voters, would repeal a law which has been declared unconstitutional by the California Supreme Court. This law was the Alien Property Initiative Act of 1920 which prohibited leasing of land to aliens and putting other restrictions upon them. This initiative has been passed by the Legislature now requires voter ratification. There is no opposition to this measure. Vote Yes on No. 13.
