Larue Slated For KF Talk
Dr. Gerald Larue is scheduled to be the main speaker at a meeting at St. Paul's Episcopal Church Tuesday evening, October 30, at 7:30. Dr. Larue will speak on the Bible and will explain methods for encouraging its use in the home, church and community.
The meeting is being sponsored by the Klamath Council of Churches and is open to the public, according to Ross Ragland, president of the council. Plans for the meeting are being completed by Mrs. Robert H. Davies, Bible Committee chairman for the Klamath Women's Council and the Reverend M. A. McKinnis, Bible chairman for the Council of Churches.
This is the third year in a five year statewide program launched by the Oregon Council of Churches to encourage greater use and understanding of the Bible.
Dr. Larue, a recognized Bible scholar and leader in interdenominational work, has held pastorates in Canada and California and has been on the faculty of the Pacific School of Religion in Berkeley. His talk in Klamath Falls will be one in a series which will cover the entire state.
