NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION

CITY OF KLAMATH FALLS

November 6, 1956

Pursuant to Resolutions and Ordinances adopted by the Common Council of the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, the Charter of said City and Laws of Oregon:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that a special election will be held in said City of Klamath Falls, Oregon, and in the several wards and precincts thereof, on Tuesday, the 6th day of November, 1956, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of said City, one charter amendment and one other measure, each proposed by the Common Council of said City, the ballot title and number of the measure being as follows:

"SHALL THE WATERS FOR DOMESTIC USE FOR THE PUBLIC OF THE CITY OF KLAMATH FALLS, OREGON, BE TREATED WITH FLUORIDES, GENERALLY KNOWN AS FLUORIDATION?"

"SHALL CHARTER OF KLAMATH FALLS, OREGON, BE AMENDED BY AUTHORIZING AN ANNUAL LEVY THAT WILL BE \$200,000, OVER ALL DEBT LIMITATION, BEGINNING JULY 1, 1957, AND FOR EACH YEAR THEREAFTER TO BE USED TO FINANCE THAT CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT?"

ON EACH PROPOSAL YOU WILL VOTE YES, OR YOU WILL VOTE NO.

A copy of the proposed charter amendment and of each of the said measures is on file in the office of the Police Judge, in the City Hall of said City, where they may be inspected by the electors.

The polls and voting places for said election will be open at the hour of eight o'clock in the forenoon of said day and remain open until the hour of eight o'clock in the afternoon of said day, during which period electors may cast their ballots.
