'Old Friend' Turns Robber

DORRIS — "Sometimes you lose more than you make by giving service on a 24-hour basis," Harry Moore, operator of Moore's, Texaco Service Station, grocery and coffee shop, told Police Chief Byard Kelly late Friday.

Moore usually works nights with Mrs. Dee Blair employed during the day shift. When she was unable to work on Friday, Moore continued to operate the business until "an old friend" drove up in an old model Pontiac for gasoline.

Moore told Kelly that he remembered the man from World War II days, when his "friend" was operating a service station at Tulelake, so he asked him if he would take care of the business for a few hours while Moore went home and got some sleep.

Later in the day, a tobacco salesman drove in, and finding the place open and the gas pumps unlocked but nobody on duty, he reported the situation to Mrs. Virginia Hamilton when he was unable to locate the police chief who was patrolling. A laundry driver came along shortly thereafter and he found Kelly who notified Moore.

On checking the premises, Moore discovered that \$39.73 which he had left in the cash register was missing and that \$2.63, which had been rung up in his absence, was also gone.

The crushing blow came, however, when Moore admitted to the police chief that he can't remember his "friend's" name.
