## Brando's Wife Still Mystery

**HOLLYWOOD** — The question of whether Marlon Brando's bride was Anna Kashfi, Indian actress, or Johanna O'Callaghan of Cardiff, Wales, still has Hollywood buzzing today.

It appears possible that she was both; that is, that Joan O'Callaghan, actually born in India, took an Indian name and atmosphere for her theatrical career.

On the other hand, she told Hollywood friends that she was Indian and on her marriage license she listed her birthplace as Darjeeling, India, and her father as Devi Kashfi.

Nevertheless, William Patrick O'Callaghan of Cardiff, a Welsh factory worker and former railroad man in India, says that Anna Kashfi is his daughter, Joan, born in India while he was employed there. And MGM studio says her paychecks were issued in the name of Johanna O'Callaghan.

Whether she is Anna or Joan, the 23-year-old beauty is now Mrs. Marlon Brando and has been since she and the 33-year-old actor were married in nearby Eagle Rock Friday.

Newsman and studio people have been unable to locate the honeymooning couple since to ask about O'Callaghan's parental claim. When the bridal couple left by automobile, Brando said he didn't know, himself, just where they were going.

## PRINCE RECOVERS

**LONDON** — Prince Charles, 8-year-old son of Queen Elizabeth, has recovered from his bout of Asian flu and is back at classes, Buckingham Palace said Monday. The young prince became a flu victim 12 days ago.

## CONVICTS FREED

**OTTAWA** — About 300 Canadian convicts were free men Monday under an order of amnesty in honor of Queen Elizabeth's visit. Another 15,000 prisoners in federal and provincial prisons throughout the dominion received one-twelfth reductions of their sentences.

## Army To Take Command Of Newest Missile Project

**WHITE SANDS PROVING GROUND, N.M.** — The Army formally takes possession tomorrow of one of the newest eggs in the United States missile basket.

The occasion is the formal transfer to the Army—by the Navy and Radio Corporation of America—of Talos.

Talos has been described as a deadly missile hunting dog, chained to an electronic leash. Capable of rapid fire and the first completely automatic unit, it ranks in the anti-missile class of U.S. weapons. The ram-jet propelled missile is believed the first

supersonic rocket developed for use by both land and sea-going units.

Against a background of controversy, charge and counter-charge over the nation's missile program, top Army, Navy and scientific officials will be on hand for the ceremony. A press corps of sizeable dimensions is invited to attend firings of the missile.

Among those scheduled to attend the formal ceremonies at this desert proving ground are Lt. Gen. E. L. Cummings, chief of Army ordnance; Rear Adm. F. S. Wittington, of the Navy Bureau of Ordnance; and Dr. E. W. Engstrom, senior executive vice president and top scientist for RCA.

An unusual economic factor is involved in the ceremonies. Talos is believed to be the first missile developed for operational use both by the Navy and the Army.

Originally, it was a Navy pet, designed for ship-to-air use against invading enemy planes—and invading enemy missiles.

Some 10 years ago a decision was reached high in the Department of Defense to study its possibilities as a land-to-air missile. The Navy was given the job of developing Talos for this purpose and RCA became the prime contractor.

RCA has been reluctant to tell what it knows of Talos' capabilities until formal release of information.

## Education Head's Remarks Rapped

**COLOMBO, Ceylon** — Education Minister W. Dahanayake has gotten into trouble with West Germany because of some of his recent remarks to U. S. Ambassador Maxwell Gluck.

Dr. Theodor M. Auer, West German minister in Ceylon, criticized Dahanayake for his comment to Gluck that no foreign embassy had helped Ceylon with its educational problems.

Auer noted that Germany had given Ceylon a technical workshop worth more than \$300,000. He asked whether Ceylon is interested in Germany's contributions.

Foreign Ministry spokesman Gumasena de Soysa told Auer Ceylon is grateful for the help. He said the education minister's views are not those of the government.

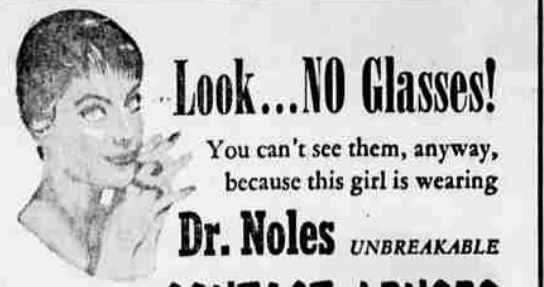

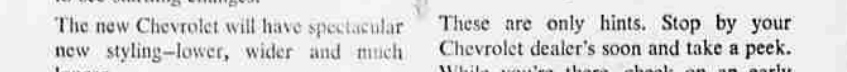

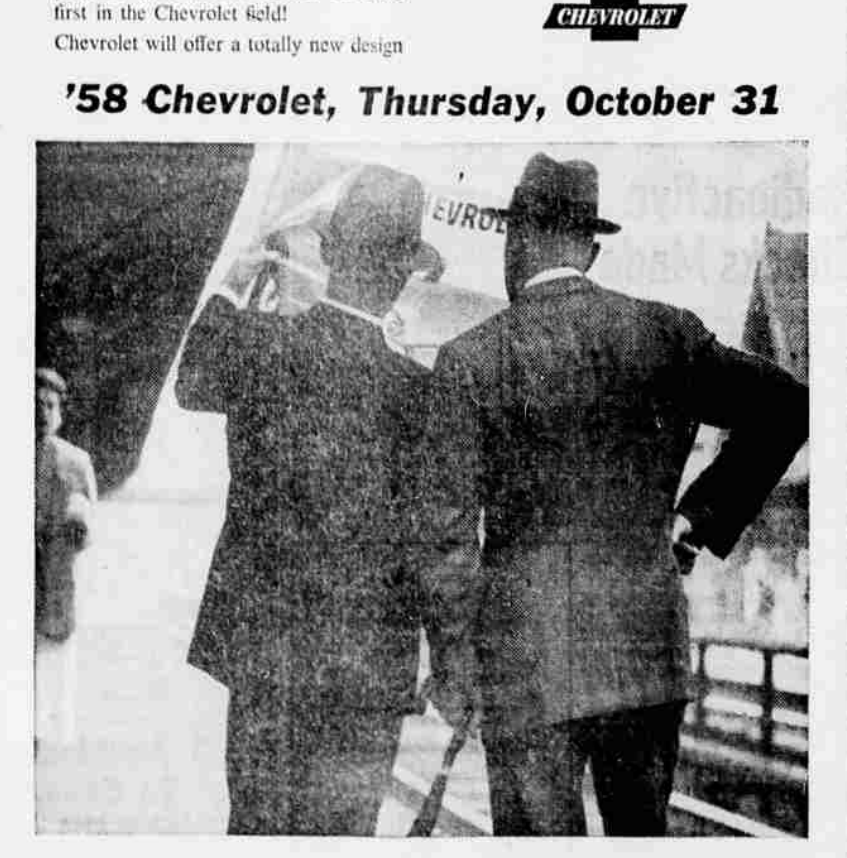
