STOCKHOLM (AP)—Albert Camus, a French novelist and one of the sharpest contemporary critics of totalitarianism of all kinds, today won the 1957 Nobel Prize for Literature.

New Pakistan Leader Named

KARACHI, Pakistan (AP)—President Iskander Mirza today named Ismail Chundrigar, president of the Moslem League, to become Pakistan's sixth prime minister.

A government announcement said he would take the oath of office later today.

Chundrigar was chosen to succeed Prime Minister H. S. Suhrawardy of the Awami League after the Republican party, the Moslem League and the Workers and Tenants party agreed to join in a coalition cabinet.

American observers expect the new government to be dominated by the Republicans, Pakistan's strongest political party, and to continue Suhrawardy's pro-Western policy of close alliance with the United States and strong allegiance to the Baghdad and SEATO pacts.

Zhukov Ends Yugoslav Tour

BELGRADE, Yugoslavia (AP)—Marshal Georgi K. Zhukov, Soviet defense minister, left Yugoslavia today, after a nine-day visit during which he inspected military installations and watched small-scale maneuvers of Yugoslav army units.

He left in a Soviet military plane for Tirana, capital of Communist Albania.

Without going out of its way, President Tito's government gave Zhukov the treatment required by protocol for a visiting defense minister from a sister Communist state.

Editorial Calls For Change In Policy On English Queen

LONDON (AP)—The controversy over how Queen Elizabeth II should do her job continued today with an editorial calling for removal of the "velvet curtain" between the Queen and her people.

The pro-Labor Daily Mirror, which claims a circulation of 4 1/2 million, said the 31-year-old monarch is the victim of her own court circle—professional courtiers, flunkies, advisers, hangers-on, the relics who still see Queen Victoria's ghost walking in the palace corridors.

"The truth is that reform of the court is overdue," it said. "There is still far too great a gulf between the royal family and the people."

"Why," the paper continued, "should the Queen have to wait until her Canadian trip before she can emerge as a polished, assured TV star? (Elizabeth made her first live television appearance—an informal speech to the Canadian people—during her visit to Ottawa.)"

"Why can the Queen be televised opening Parliament in Can-

ada but not—yet—opening Parliament in London?"

"Why, in Paris, could the Queen, smiling and unflustered, spend 15 utterly informal minutes literally mobbed by thousands of guests at a reception?"

"Don't blame the Queen. She is young and human—human enough to kick off her shoes when her feet hurt."

"Don't blame the Duke of Edinburgh. He is human enough—and why not?—to tell press photographers to go to hell when he feels like it."

"Why can't this humanity get through to the people more than it does now?"

The Conservative tabloid Daily Sketch, on the other hand, insisted that most Britons want the royal family to conduct itself in accordance with tradition.

"The wish of the everyday ordinary people is that the Queen should stay exactly the way she is," insisted the Sketch.

"They like the Queen they have. They don't want a custom-made Queen, made to the measure of her critics."

The fuss over royalty started with a critical outburst by Lord Altrincham, 33-year-old peer, John Osborne, 29-year-old playwright
