Starting in 1958, the Soil Bank will offer five or 10-year contracts at the option of the producer, for tree or shrub plantings for shelterbelts, wind-breaks, or wildlife habitats. The present 10-year contract requirement remains in effect on tree plantings for forestry purposes.

Each county will be represented by one boy and girl, 16 or older. From this group, two young men and women will be selected for Washington trips.

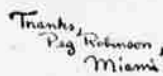
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WANT-AD WONDERS
