

Savory Short Ribs

Cooked until they are so tender the meat falls from the bone, beef short ribs are about the tastiest meat you could serve for a fall dinner. An economical cut from the ends of standing rib roasts, short ribs have all the full meat flavor of the more expensive cuts.

To insure the most tender short ribs, long slow cooking—braising—is best. Brown the meat and simmer it in a little liquid until tender. While the meat is cooking, prepare fresh fall carrots, apples and onions to complete the main course.

In the following recipe, instructions are given for preparing braised short ribs with apple and onion rings. A light browning in a little butter is enough to leave the ribs slightly crisp.

While the ribs finish braising, cook scraped whole carrots in a little boiling, salted water until tender, about 15 to 20 minutes. Season them with butter and sprinkle with parsley before serving.

SAVORY SHORT RIBS

2½ pounds beef short ribs

3 tablespoons flour
3 tablespoons lard or drippings
2 teaspoons Worcestershire sauce
2 teaspoons salt
1 teaspoon pepper
1 cup water
3 large unpeeled red-skinned apples, sliced thickly
2 to 3 tablespoons butter or margarine

2 large onions, sliced thickly
Roll meat in flour and brown in hot fat. Add Worcestershire sauce, salt, pepper and water. Cover pan and cook over low heat two hours or until meat is tender. Remove seeds from apple slices; brown lightly in melted butter. Remove apples from pan and brown onions in fat. Arrange apples and onions around meat on platter. Pour in five servings.
