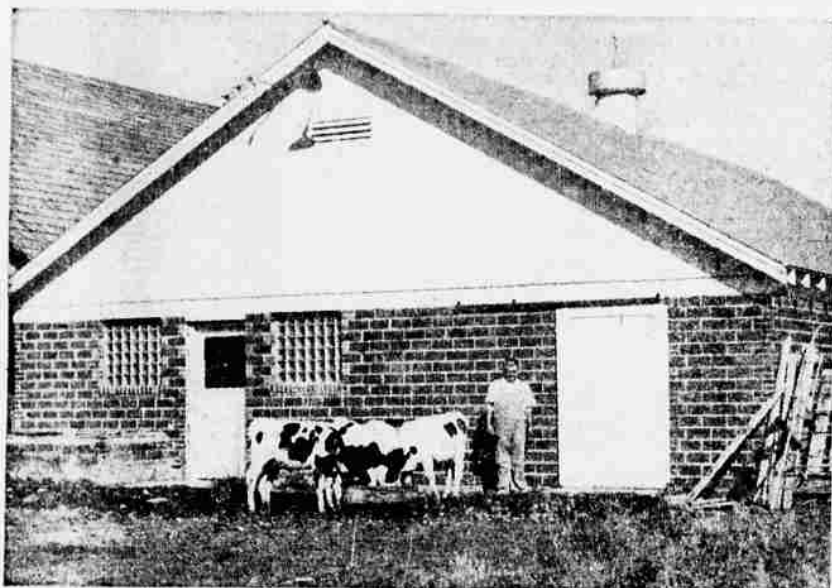




From Klamath's Spotlessly Clean Dairies . . . Comes Fresh Local Grade "A" Milk!
