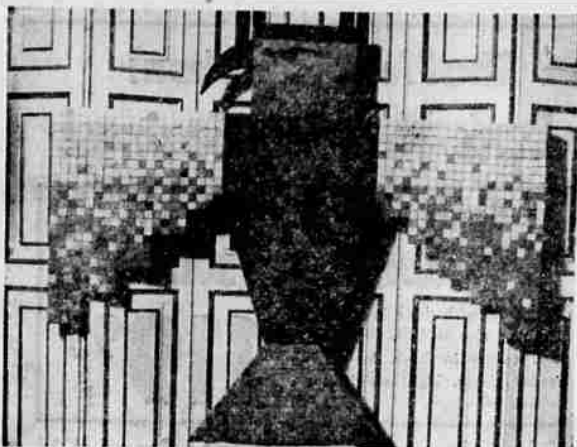




HIGHLY COLORED ceramic Thunderbird highlights the entrance to the new Town and Country Branch of The United States National Bank of Portland which opens as the second Klamath Falls branch of the U.S. National on Saturday, November 9, in the Town and Country Shopping Center on South Sixth Street. Morrison and Howard was the architectural firm and Duncan Construction Company was the builder.

COLORFUL DECOR HIGHLIGHTS BANK

The ceramic Thunderbird highlighting the entrance to the new Town and Country Branch of The United States National Bank of Portland, was drawn by Shirley Sortwell, a Chiloquin Elementary School student. Because her design was chosen, Shirley will be presented with a \$25 savings account at the official opening of the new bank branch on Saturday to Elton W. Smith, manager of the Town and Country branch.

Shirley has submitted her design for possible use as a decoration for the Chiloquin school which was built in 1955. The colored photograph of the ceramic Thunderbird was held in the files of Morrison and Howard, architects for the school and the new bank building. The crayon drawing was made into a mural by a Portland artist, Patti Redfield.

Reproduced on the wall facing the glassed-in entrance to the new modern bank building, the Thunderbird measures four feet from wing tip to wing tip and stands about four feet high. The figure is done in mosaic in shades of vivid blue, green, black, red and orange ceramic tile and forms a striking wall decoration entirely in keeping with the Klamath country served by the bank.

According to Western Indian lore, the Thunderbird is the sacred bearer of all true happiness

and is a symbol much used in Indian ceremonies.

The choice of colors throughout the building ties in with the mural in the entrance foyer. The colors were coordinated by Mrs. Lila Colwell, interior decorator, A.I.D.

EXPANSION

Additional area was incorporated into the new Town and Country branch bank building which can be used to expand the main banking room when needed. The expansion can be accomplished economically by removing the south wall adjacent to the tellers' counter, adding approximately 2,000 square feet for operation.

BANKING HOURS

Longer banking time is provided at the Town and Country branch which is open from 10 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. on week days through Friday and from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Saturdays.

COMFORTABLE

The new Town and Country Branch of U.S. National is heated by a gas-fired furnace with hot air ducts installed beneath the floor slab. For cooling, an evaporator cooler has been installed to further the comfort of customers and employees during the summer months.

UNIQUE

The same check book is used for both the downtown and Town and Country branches of The U.S. National Bank of Portland.

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
