# Scandal Case Deal Related

HOLLYWOOD (UP)—An agreement has been reached whereby Confidential and Whisper magazines will revise their editorial policy in exchange for dismissal of criminal libel charges against individual defendants.

The magazines, affiliated corporations and Mr. and Mrs. Fred Meade, West Coast information agents for the publications, were tried last fall but a jury deadlocked after a lengthy trial and was dismissed.

Under the agreement reached between the attorney general's office and defense attorney Arthur Crowley, charges against the Meades would be dismissed and the magazines would stand trial on the basis of the transcript of their earlier trial.

As part of the agreement, Confidential Publisher Robert Harrison will publish advertisements in New York, Chicago and Los Angeles.

# U.S. Submarine On World Trip

HONOLULU (AP)—The Gudgeon, flagship of the U.S. Navy's Pacific submarine force, is on a voyage that will make it the first U.S. submarine to travel around the world.

The Gudgeon is en route from the Philippines to Colombo, Ceylon, where it is due Nov. 13. It started July 8 from Pearl Harbor and went to Yokosuka, Japan, and then to the Philippines.

The sub's 23,411-mile voyage should take 90 days, the Navy said.

# NEW FRENCH PARTY FORMED

PARIS (UP)—A newly-formed ultra right-wing political party said today its avowed intention is to destroy the present regime in France and guillotine "traitors" if it comes to power. The new party—the 14th in France—is the Revolutionary Patriot Party founded by Jean-Baptiste Biaggi, a turbulent right-winger. Formation of the party means the emergence of an extremist right-wing group which is the direct heir to the various neo-Fascist leagues which plagued political life toward the end of the Third Republic—before the last war broke out.
