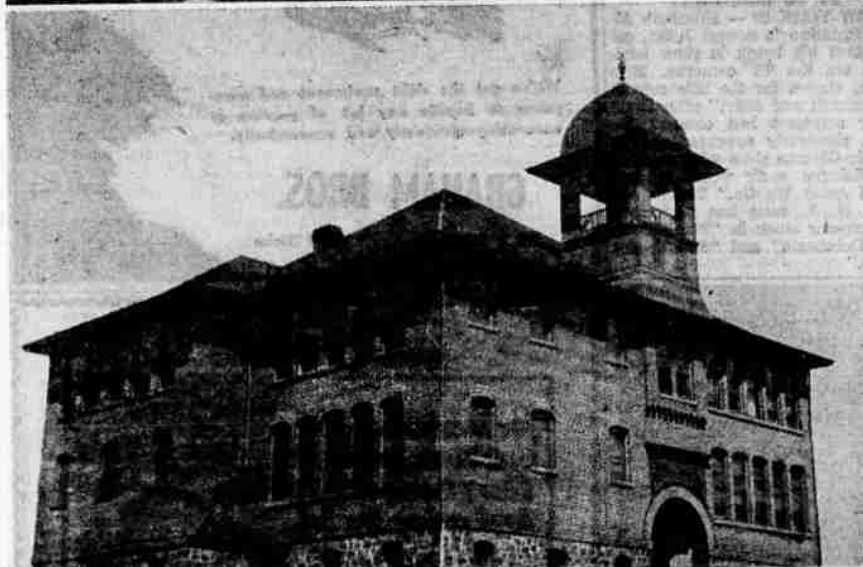
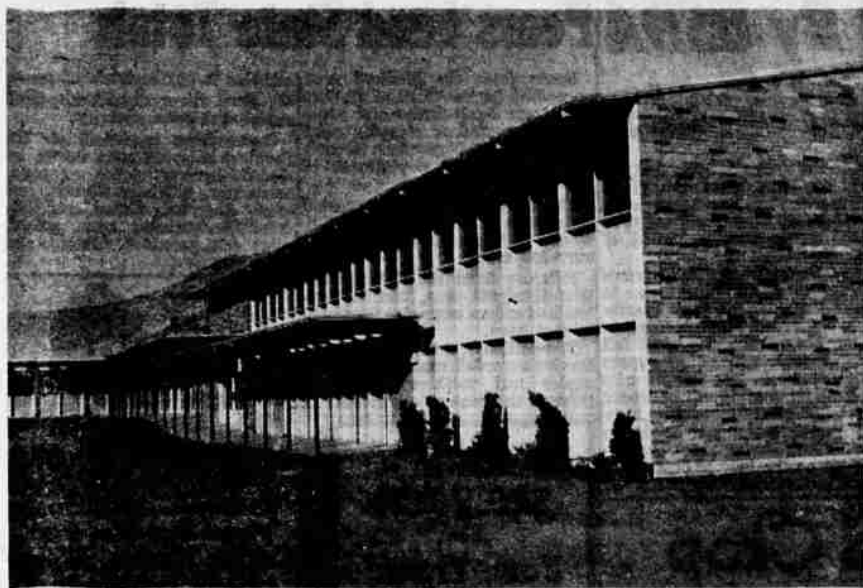

Predatory Kill In State Listed

Known livestock losses in Oregon from destruction by predatory animals totaled 1,234 animals and poultry during April, May, and June, including 854 sheep, 34 goats, 19 calves, 192 chickens, 47 geese, 175 turkeys, and 13 ducks. These figures come from Mel Smith, district agent for the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, and M. E. Knickerbocker, animal division chief of the Oregon Department of Agriculture.

These figures should not be considered total livestock losses due to predators; they are ones actually found by the federal-state predator hunters. In addition to these stock losses, 29 game animals and birds were found killed.

Baker County was hardest hit in livestock losses due to predators. In this area coyotes killed 52 sheep and bobcats destroyed 50 more. Lane and Yamhill counties suffered the greatest poultry losses, with 117 and 91 deaths, respectively.

Coyotes were responsible for over half the losses occurring during these months. Bobcats, foxes, and dogs were next on the list of predators causing deaths, in that order.

Soil Reserve Changes Set

Changes in the Soil Bank conservation reserve program for 1958 will be of interest to part-time farmers as well as farmers in summer-fallow areas and owners of marginal cropland, according to M. D. Thomas, extension agricultural economist at Oregon State College.

Farmers are now being encouraged to put whole farm units under the program, and to take part in more forestry and wildlife practices, Thomas says. Duration of contracts under this program now range from three to 10 years.

Payments covering up to 80 per cent of the cost of establishing land in the conservation reserve, plus annual rental payments, are

provided under 1958 Soil Bank contracts. Annual payments up to \$5,000 per farm may now be received under the program.

Signup for the 1958 conservation reserve will soon be underway at county ASC offices. And since there may be further changes in program provisions, Thomas recommends interested farmers check with their county ASC office or county extension agent for more information to help plan a program for their farm.

Cairo, Illinois, was so named because its first settlers, who arrived in 1818, thought its delta site was like that of Cairo, Egypt.

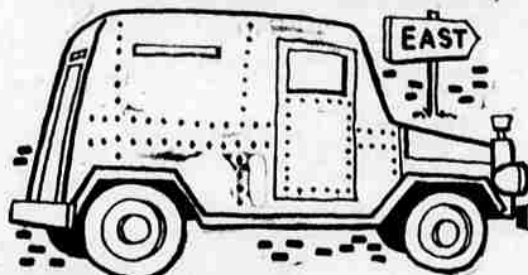
