The announcement came on the heels of reports received in Tokyo which indicate that food shortages and growing peasant dissatisfaction have caused minor revolts.

Bird Watchers Count 146 Species In Basin Count

One hundred and forty six different forms of bird life were observed during the nine day bird watching project of the Nature Society held during the period of October 26 to November 3.

Twenty-one birds were reported by only five observers, these: Cackling Goose, Green-winged Teal, Cinnamon Teal, Bald Eagle, Chucker Partridge, Wilson's Snipe, DOWITCHER, Hairy Woodpecker, White-headed Woodpecker, Say's Phoebe, White-breasted Nuthatch, Red-breasted Nuthatch, Marsh Wren, Varied Thrush, Mountain Bluebird, Golden-crowned Kinglet, American Pipit, Cedar Waxwing, Northwestern Shrike, Evening Grosbeak, Cassin's Purple Finch.

Four observers reported on 17 other species — Lesser Canada Goose, Blue-winged Teal, Hooded Merganser, Peregrine Falcon, Sooty Grouse, Great Horned Owl, Williamson's Sapsucker, Oregon Jay, Chestnut-backed Chickadee, Pygmy Owl, Water Ouzel, Ruby-crowned Kinglet, Yellow-headed Blackbird, Red Wing, Pine Siskin, Red Cross Bill and Savannah Sparrow.

Three observers contributed 11 species — Ferruginous, Rough-legged Hawk, Prairie Falcon, Wilson's Phalarope, Western Mourning Dove, Great Grey Owl, Downy Woodpecker, Raven, Winter Wren, Western Wood Pewee, Brown Towhee and Black-necked Stilt.

Eleven species were seen by only two observers, these were American Bittern, Wood Duck, Barrows Golden-eye, White-winged Scoter, Sharp-shinned Hawk, Ruffed Grouse, Sage Hen, Screech Owl, Pygmy Owl, Long-eared Owl, Poorwill, Western Pileated Woodpecker, Lewis's Woodpecker, Red-naped Sapsucker, Arctic Three-toed Woodpecker, Horned Lark, Pinon Jay, Bush Tit, Hairy Wren, Common Gold Finch, Green-backed Gold Finch, Fox Sparrow, Vesper Sparrow, Lark Sparrow, Lincoln's Sparrow and Russet-backed Thrush.

Birds commonly seen in previous October checks but not reported this time were: Brewster's Snowy Egret, Anthony's Green Heron, Turkey Vulture, Osprey, Mountain Quail, Sandhill Crane, Little Brown Crane, Forrester's Tern, Black Tern, Barn Owl, Saw-whet Owl, Western Kingbird, Crow, Canyon Wren, Rock Wren, Warbling Vireo, Tri-colored Red Wing, Pine Grosbeak, Green-tailed Towhee and Slate-colored Junco.

Leadership Plea Made

CHICAGO (UP)—Sen. Kerr (D-Okl.) urged President Eisenhower today to "give even more dynamic leadership" to a drive to overcome Russian missile supremacy.

Kerr, a frequent critic both of Eisenhower and of his administration, said, "There have been faults and mistakes by those in high places, but we cannot win the future by reshaping old errors."

In a speech prepared for the American Petroleum Institute, Kerr said Russia's launching of two satellites makes it "perfectly clear that Russia is far ahead in the development and production of the intercontinental ballistic missile, which he described as "the most decisive weapon yet conceived by the mind of man."

Contending unity is needed not only among people of this country but among its allies, he said. "We must develop a plan that will make the most effective use of our abundant spiritual, mental and physical resources. We must bring about the full mobilization of these resources."

"The President of the United States—great patriot that he is—must give even more dynamic leadership of all of the people of the United States. He must order full steam ahead for a united and mobilized nation."
