

King Pledges Arab Support

AMMAN, Jordan (AP)—Trying to counter a mounting propaganda attack from Syria, Egypt and Russia, King Hussein has renewed assurances that Jordan will never give in on the Palestine issue. "We shall continue to defend Arab countries until your usurped homeland is restored," he told the first Arab refugee conference here yesterday. The young King said he was proud of the refugee representatives' loyalty to him in the face of "evil forces which are attempting to shatter the unity of the Jordanian people." The conference adopted a resolution condemning "the unjust campaign of lies and intrigue

launched against Hussein by the trumpets of Egyptian propaganda." Egypt, Syria and other Arab countries were urged to send representatives to Jordan's refugee camps to see "the extent of this misleading and poisonous propaganda of Egyptian radio stations." Hussein's pledge to continue to demand the return of Israeli territory struck at the heart of the latest accusations against him. The refugees, who comprise a large portion of Jordan's population, militantly oppose any suggestion of a compromise with Israel. Cairo radio a few days ago intensified its attacks on Hussein, charging that he is plotting secretly with Israel against the Arabs. Moscow radio said in an Arabic broadcast last night that Hussein is "an ally and friend of the bitterest enemies of the Arab world—the United States, Britain and Turkey." Moscow said the United States has offered Hussein 30 million dollars "as a price for splitting the Arab world."

Surgeons Gather For Convention

At least 22 countries will be represented. The group's president, Dr. Arthur W. Allen of Boston, sent word he could not attend. He has been under hospital care.
