### 'Hot Cargo' Pacts Rapped

WASHINGTON (AP)—The National Labor Relations Board has ruled that "hot cargo" contracts between unions and common carriers violate the Taft-Hartley law. The question of the validity of such agreements has been before the board previously, but yesterday's 3-2 decision marked the first time the NLRB has declared them unlawful. The board ruled the contracts valid and enforceable in 1949.
