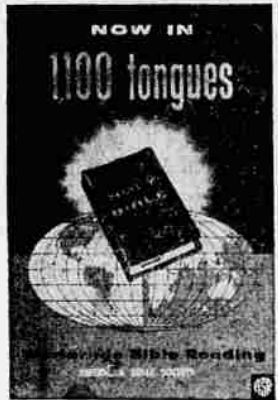

On Sunday morning, the members of the quartet and Mr. Eldridge will visit in the various classes of the 9:45 Bible School. The group will lead in the morning worship service at 11 o'clock. Mr. Eldridge will preach on the subject "How Shall They Hear Without a Preacher."

The quartet is an ensemble selected from the best singers in training at Eugene.
