

Bulls who like their music on the warm side will want to try RCA's "This Is the Night," spotlighting Bobby Brookes, and Capitol's "The Late, Late Show," in which Dakota Staton makes her album debut. And for those holiday parties, be sure to get Mercury's "Most Danceable Music," with Griff Williams and his orchestra.

ADVENTURE IN HI-FI: Many of you will be getting new high-fidelity units for Christmas, and for one of the most exciting records designed specifically for hi-fi, spin "Conflict," a study in percussion by Phil Kraus. It's on Golden Crest.

BIG SOUNDS FOR SMALL FRY: For the youngsters, Disneyland Records has three winners on the shelves. "Peter and the Wolf," coupled with "The Sorcerer's Apprentice," is beautifully recorded, and the narration by Sterling Holloway is fine. Music from the score of "Alice in Wonderland," conducted by Camarata, will enthrall the junior set, and to keep pace with the western craze, try "Creakin' Leather," with Stan Jones.

COVERING THE CLASSICS: Radiant is perhaps the best word to describe Holst's "The Planets," and Leopold Stokowski seems to be the master who can bring out all the brilliance of this work. It's the maestro's second release on Capitol. In a different mood, try "A Pops Concert in

Hi-Fi," featuring Michel Piastro, an interesting treatment of some great music. In recent weeks several versions of the Mussorgsky-Ravel "Pictures at an Exhibition" have been released. Be sure to hear Angel's before you buy. Finally, for those who like the Russian composers, try "Russkaya," a Capitol etching featuring the Hollywood Bowl Symphony Orchestra, Carmen Dragon conducting.

JAZZOMANIA: Collectors of Norman Granz' "Jam Session" series will welcome No. 9 to their libraries. It features such greats as Oscar Peterson, Dizzy Gillespie, and Buddy De Franco. Another biscuit headed for the big time is "Four Freshmen and Five Saxes," via Capitol. The award winners continue their winning ways here. "Jazz Goes to Junior College" is Dave Brubeck's latest on Columbia, and includes Paul Desmond, Norm Bates, and Joe Morello. For something truly original, spin "The Clown" with Charles Mingus and his Jazz Workshop.

"Handful of Keys" is an RCA bundle of nostalgia, for it stars the late Fats Waller at the 88. "The Warm Sound" marks the return of Frances Wayne, one of the top femme jazz singers, and this Atlantic album is most welcome. And for another whirl with the girl singers, try Teddi King's new RCA LP, "A Girl and Her Songs." Teddi seems to improve with each effort, and this is certainly her best.
