

Senator Urges Increase In Production Of Bombers

WASHINGTON (AP) — Sen. Jackson (D-Wash.) today urged a big spurt in bomber production as one of the "things we need to do immediately to stay alive."

Jackson, a frequent critic of administration defense policies, also called for a quick stepup in production of long-range missiles and nuclear submarines capable of firing such missiles. He said the Army should be built up.

In a speech prepared for the Senate, Jackson said the United States has lost "our two precious allies in past wars — time in which to mobilize, and distance to protect our homeland."

"Today whatever force is required, either to deter war or to win it if deterrence fails, must be on hand — ready at all times," he said.

Jackson did not make clear in his speech whether he felt additional funds for such an accelerated program should be included in a \$1,410,000,000 emergency defense money bill now pending, or whether he had in mind adding to the regular defense appropriations bill for the fiscal year starting July 1.

It was reported that Senate Democratic leaders decided not to try to increase the total of the emergency bill, which has passed the House and now is before the Senate Appropriations Committee. That bill is for the present fiscal year.

Senate Democratic Leader Lyndon B. Johnson of Texas was understood to have told his party colleagues he believes it would be unwise to seek any additions to the emergency bill. Johnson reportedly said such an effort might delay Senate action on the bill by opening to debate the whole defense structure.

Thus, any major effort to increase defense funds apparently will be made later in the session when the Senate takes up the administration's \$3-billion-dollar request for the coming fiscal year. That bill still is before the House Appropriations Committee.

Adm. Arthur W. Radford said he no longer is confident that "no matter what mistakes our country makes in preparing for war—the great strength of our industrial potential will fail us out."

Radford, former chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, told the National Security Industrial Assn. that "if we have to fight another

global war, we are going to fight it with what we are on hand at the time. But Radford said he believes "we are strong enough today to deter the Soviets from attacking us."

Crediting Russia with producing more long-range missiles faster, Jackson said, "The one and only way to fill the gap is by more long-range manned bombers."

"My own belief is that at least one billion dollars could now be profitably budgeted for this purpose," he said.

He called also for immediate production of long-range ballistic missiles now being tested.

He criticized administration requests to begin building nine new nuclear submarines designed to launch the Navy's Polaris, a 1,500-mile range missile. He said 15 such subs should be started immediately with an eventual goal of 100.

Finally, he asked that the Army be built up to 18 modern divisions, instead of the 14 now planned in the budget.
