Following a potluck luncheon, a

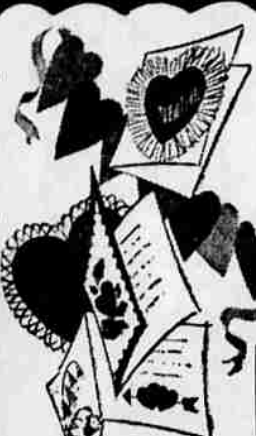
