Portland Bus Rates Hiked
PORTLAND, Ore. (U.P.)—A housewife's plea yesterday helped open the way for a fare increase that ended the immediate threat of Portland losing its mass transportation system.

Portland Bus Rates Hiked
The Rose City Transit Co. had said that if a 5-cent fare increase was not granted, it would pull its buses off the streets here Feb. 28.

Portland Bus Rates Hiked
Commissioner Ormond Bean, whose lone dissenting vote had blocked the increase in two earlier ballots, changed his mind.

Portland Bus Rates Hiked
The Council then unanimously passed an emergency ordinance permitting the firm to boost its adult fares 5 cents — to 25 cents a ride.

Bean said the housewife told him that if the company suspended its operations, her husband would lose his job and their five children might go hungry.

The commissioner said that he still basically opposed the increase, but could not bear to have the firm's employees lose their jobs, or retired employees their pensions.

He came to the United Society presidency from a successful pastorate at the Euclid Avenue Christian Church in Cleveland, Ohio.
