NAACP Franchise In Arkansas Revoked By Governor Faubus

LITTLE ROCK, Ark. (AP)—Gov. Orval Faubus revoked the state franchise of the National Assn. for the Advancement of Colored People yesterday.

Two new reports of racial incidents came out of integrated Central High School.

And Supt. Virgil Blossom recommended the expulsion of a Negro girl from the troubled school.

Faubus signed a proclamation taking the NAACP and about 300 other corporations off the roll of chartered organizations because they failed to pay 1957 franchise taxes by a Feb. 1 deadline.

His action had the effect of dissolving the NAACP in Arkansas. Under a 1953 state law, the NAACP could regain its franchise by paying delinquent taxes and applying for reinstatement.

The Little Rock school board heard Blossom's recommendation for expulsion of 16-year-old Minnie Jean Brown in a closed session.

Blossom also extended a three-day suspension that she got Friday to two weeks.

Only the school board can expel a student but it usually follows a superintendent's recommendation.

Minnie Jean got the suspension—her second—for her part in a scuffle with a white girl student. The white girl quit school.

Last December Minnie Jean was suspended for throwing chili on two white boys in a cafeteria incident.

She has been involved in several other racial clashes at Central High.

Minnie Jean is the only Negro who has been suspended since Negroes entered Central High Sept. 25 under the protection of federal troops.

A white girl and a Negro boy reported they figured in separate incidents at Central High yesterday.
