

Indian Teaching Plans Examined

CHILQUIN — Interested parents, backed by members of the Fort Klamath and Chilquín organizations, school boards and representatives of the Klamath Indian Education Office, met at Chilquín High School Thursday afternoon to discuss the advisability of an organization to promote remedial teaching facilities for intermediate or high school aged students.

It was decided that the first requirement would be research work into the problem to see whether the same type of training would be suitable for all, or whether a diversified plan would be more advantageous. The second goal was to determine whether present school facilities plus added assistance from the county would take care of the cost, or if parents would have to hire extra help as an organization.

Mrs. Dwight Kircher will act as temporary chairman and Mrs. Donald Potter, temporary secretary. A meeting time was set for Thursday, February 27, at 3:30 p.m. in the high school. All parents of students with a learning problem are especially invited to attend.
