Scholarship Program Set

Consolidated Freightways, Inc., will award 18 first-year scholarships to high school seniors who plan to enter the teaching profession. The awards will be made to students living in communities of less than 75,000 population which have terminals of Consolidated Freightways, W. H. Roemhildt, local manager, announced today.

"This means that high school seniors living in Klamath Falls, Merrill, Malin, Henley and Tulelake are eligible to apply for a \$500 scholarship from Consolidated if they are planning to prepare themselves for the teaching profession," Roemhildt said.

Candidates are to submit their applications to a local nominating committee. This committee will select one student as the community's scholarship nominee, to forwarding his application to a final judging committee at Menlo Park, California.

Roemhildt, Klamath Falls manager of Central Oregon East Freight, a Consolidated Freightways division, lives at 4643 Boardman Street and is organizing the Klamath Basin program. The 18 final winners will be chosen from among 62 nominees. All nominees who do not win scholarships will receive \$50 "book money" awards in recognition of being selected to represent their communities in the competition, Roemhildt said.

Consolidated first awarded "Highway to Learning" scholarships in 1957, when general requirements of its annual scholarship program were revised to encourage young teachers-to-be. The original program was established in December, 1951, to replace the traditional practice of giving Christmas remembrances to customers. Before 1957 the scholarships were granted without regard to career aims of the applicants.

"The scholarship rules were revised in 1957 to help counter the nation's alarming shortage of teachers," J. L. S. Sneed Jr., C-F president, said. "Since the educational needs of our country are even more apparent today, the company will continue its emphasis on teaching in 1958."

In addition to the 18 scholarships for students in smaller terminal cities, C-F will award six scholarships at large to students living in terminal cities of more than 75,000 population.

Winners will be selected on the basis of their scholastic records, extra-curricular activities, personal statements, faculty recommendations and their aptitude and promise for teaching. The applications must be filed with the local committees on or before March 28, 1958.
