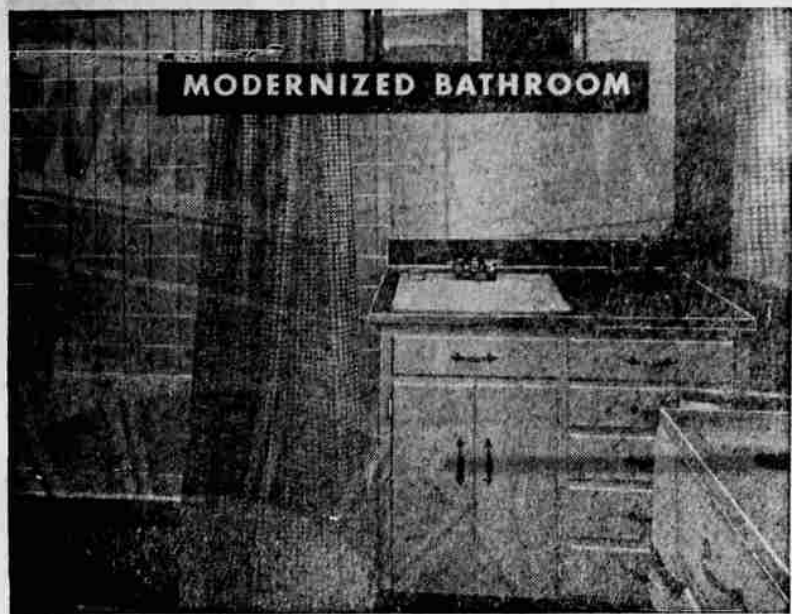
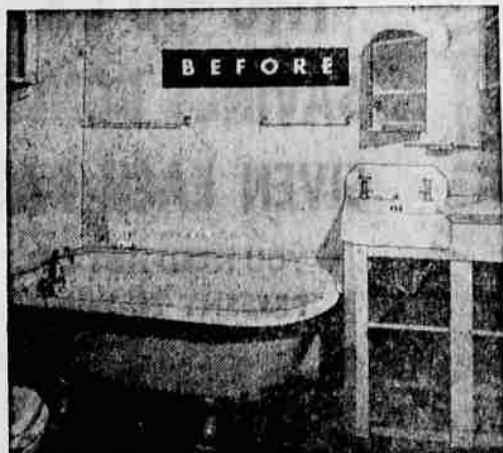




MODERNIZED BATHROOM

BEFORE AND AFTER: Before remodeling, the bathroom looked old, without comfort or convenience. The old-style tub was difficult to get into, difficult to clean under and around. Little storage room was available.

WHEN REMODELED — the same bathroom takes on an entirely new look. A new vanity, countertop lavatory, bathtub - shower combination, new tile, etc. — all stress comfort, convenience and ease-of-up-keep.

SAVING TIP

You can reduce the cost of fuel for heating water by following these tips when possible: use a pan rather than running it; take a shower rather than a bath; don't let faucets drip; use cool water when it will do as well; keep heater clean and adjusted; flush storage tank regularly; and last, operate the flame as low as possible.

Kitchen Modernization Demands Pre-Planning For Long-Range Utility

Modernize your kitchen for greater convenience, comfort and, most of all, liveability.

Your modernized (or new) kitchen should express your personality and provide time and work-saving arrangements.

Basically, all rooms are divided into three basic shapes — the "ONE-WALL," shape — that permits you to work in one line of left to right, right-to-left. If space is limited, often this "strip" plan is the most ideal.

"L-SHAPE" — when you have two adjoining walls, the L-shape provides an ideal work triangle.

"U-SHAPE" — where all of three walls are available — it is one of the most efficient shapes for kitchen efficiency.

No matter what basic shape your kitchen may have — if the room center is open, you can gain extra work and counter facilities by the use of islands and peninsulas for storage and working surfaces.

Remember, you'll want to provide room for FOOD - STORAGE - refrigerator - freezer for the fresh items and ample cabinets to hold staples and canned goods.

COOKING CENTER — your cooking and baking units may be handled as an all-in-one item — or by individual units.

Work surfaces for preparing food, storage facilities for utensils and appliances should be placed as close as possible to this center.

DISH - WASHING AND WASTE DISPOSING — The ideal area for these tasks should be conveniently-placed between the cooking and food storage area.

Extras you may want to consider in your "new" kitchen may encompass such items as sit-down sinks; desks; serving or eating bars; pass-throughs to the dining area; hanging cabinets; built-in refrigerators and freezers; built-in T.V.'s and many of the others too numerous to mention.

Popular choices for cabinets are all steel units in white and a wide-range of colors; new copper tones — achieved by enamel and plating; stainless steel in mirror or satin finishes; fine wood units that show natural grains, or take on high-gloss enamels — or the newest of all — units that are enamel-in-color steel with wood-grain doors.

Electrically-speaking, an entirely new vista of convenience awaits the kitchen planner. Fresh from the drawing boards have come such innovations as a work-center of mixer, grinder, blender, juicer etc. All operating on one motor — the motor being the built-in unit.

A new combination timer-wiring center with pull - out extension cords and outlets handles a multiple of appliances at once.

New too, is the combination sink with waste-disposer, dishwasher and water supply — all under one counter top.

New fixtures and lighting providing incandescent and fluorescent lighting are devised to take kitchen work out of the shadows.

Ventilating fans and room air conditioners are also practical additions to the kitchen. If you intend to remodel your present kitchen: start with plans that are complete and mechanically-sound. It is costly to make alterations after work has started. Visualized to meet your budget, needs, space and personal tastes, can save extra expense and worry.

Plant Trees Add Beauty

Flowering trees are beautiful anywhere on the property, says the American Association of Nurserymen, but you should plant them where they will achieve maximum effect and serve a definite purpose.

At a corner of the property toward the street is an excellent location, the tree being planted so you can look at it from the front windows of the house, and where neighbors will exclaim over its loveliness.

Another good location is a corner of the house to help, with other shrubs, to frame the house and tie it to the ground in a natural way.

At a driveway entrance is another likely location. Here both your family and visitors will be placed in a happy mood as they see it when in flower.

In your outdoor living room and in the back yard flowering trees can serve both for beauty and comfort, as they will give welcome summer shade.

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Handy Short Cuts Aid Clean-Up

Take the "Rome wasn't built in a day" approach to your spring house - cleaning this year. Give yourself plenty of time — but PLAN that time.

You can eliminate most of the drudgery and backaches in your "Operation Spring Cleaning" and get better results if you spread the job, carefully planned, over several days.

Make a survey of the house and schedule your cleaning chores for each day so that you'll have plenty of time for rest, too!

When you get ready to work, dress for the job — and your comfort. Wear slacks, shorts, or a comfortable dress. Anything that allows plenty of freedom of movement. Low heeled shoes will keep your feet at ease and reduce the possibility of accidents from tripping or stumbling.

Liquid starch to give curtains and cottons that crisp new look. Window cleaner (in easy-to-hold bottles) with a spray applicator for cleaning windows, mirrors and all glass surfaces.

New oven cleaner which comes with its own applicator. Use the applicator to apply the cleaning paste and wipe clean with a cloth. Stubborn grease stains and burnt-in food particles also disappear like magic.

Liquid Furniture Polish, the kind you apply with a cloth, and just wipe off to get a glowing sheen and lasting protection. Liquid bleach for cleaning and sanitizing bathrooms, kitchen tile, sink, refrigerator and range.

Bottled turpentine for bothersome paint spots — and for use in the painting jobs which should be a part of every house-cleaning program.

Non-inflammable cleaning fluid for gummy smudges on all floors and woodwork.

The first step is to list all the supplies and equipment you will need to do the job right.

Take advantage of all the new products on the market which were especially created to make your job easier and a lot more pleasant.

For instance, there's creamy paste on the market to protect your hands and fingernails from the familiar, telltale signs of cleaning.

Applied like a lotion, the paste keeps off unsightly and hard-to-remove dirt from under fingernails and in the pores of the skin. And, it's easily removed with the dirt when you wash.

Other cleaning aids you'll want to include:

Bottled detergents to make quick liquid suds for washing dishes, nylon, rayon, silks, and woollens.
