Gang Chief Says Fatal Attack On Youth Was Spontaneous

NEW YORK (AP) — The prime minister of a teen-age street gang has testified that the attack last summer that cost 15-year-old Michael Farmer his life was spontaneous.

Farmer, a polio cripple, was beaten and stabbed to death July 30 in the Washington Heights section of upper Manhattan. Seven boys from 15 to 18 are on trial for their lives in the slaying.

The state contends Farmer was an innocent bystander who crossed the path of a war party of Egyptian Dragons in search of members of the rival Jesters gang. Farmer apparently belonged to no gang.

Howard Rowan, a six-foot Negro youth, testified that he understood he and his fellow Egyptian Dragons were in quest of a peace parley with the Jesters, not war. Nevertheless, he recalled that various of the defendants were armed with knives, sticks and a weighted dog chain.

Rowan, 16 now but 15 at the time of the attack, said his duties as prime minister consisted of looking over new gang members. The grand jury did not indict him for the crime, and he was committed to an institution for juvenile delinquents. He said he was unarmed during the attack and took no part in it.

Ten other young members of the Egyptian Dragons similarly were treated as juvenile rather than adult offenders.

The seven older Egyptian Dragons face the electric chair if convicted of first-degree murder.

Their General Sessions Court trial is nearing the end of its first month. After preliminary police testimony, the stage began calling members of the Egyptian Dragons as witnesses. Rowan was the fourth to take the stand.

The Egyptian Dragons were an integrated gang, operating in an area of Manhattan where Negro and Puerto Rican families have moved into property once predominantly white.

Two of the boys on trial are white. Two are Negro. Two are Puerto Rican and one is from the Dominican Republic. The white boys are John McCarthy, 15, and Richard Hills, also 15. The Negroes are Charles (Big Man) Norton and Leroy (The Magician) Birch, both 18. The others are Lencio de Leon, 15, and George Melendez and Louis Alvarez, both 16.

attitude and intolerance. "Do the thing and you'll have the power," said Evans, quoting Ralph Waldo Emerson, in describing his fifth ingredient, which was participation. He added that bread must be earned by the sweat of the brow, and indicated that the bread will be sweeter if there is active participation in the earning.

Next came humility. He told the club that many things are known: How to launch satellites, how to make synthetics, but man does not know how to create a worm or a blade of grass, therefore, man must be humble.

"I don't wish to make this sound like a sermon, but in my prescription, there must be prayer and we must accept it without knowing what it is," He added that following prayer, there is also re-

pentance, which one's life would be frustrated without.

He also listed freedom and said that sometimes in search of security, freedom is given up. "But no matter what we exchange it for, we've made a bad bargain. We wouldn't be more than vegetarians without freedom.
