

CHEESE

If you had to choose just one variety from the great family of cheeses, one to serve all purposes and please all tastes, you would undoubtedly choose cheddar. But, because of the great variation in aged-cheddar, even that choice has its problems.

Father likes it with a decided nipiness to go with robust breads such as rye and pumpernickel, and to enjoy with fruit and crackers. Junior wants it mild for his lunch box sandwiches and cheeseburgers, leaving mother looking for a happy medium to suit all tastes when she uses cheddar in made dishes.

Solution? A superb natural cheddar is now appearing on our cheese counters as a "family pack"—a three-in-one pleaser offering a choice of its mild, medium, and well-aged cheese—a convenient sized half-pound of each bundled together into one handsomely-dressed collection. This is certainly the answer to the homemaker's shopping dilemma, and a new idea indeed by way of "convenience foods."

But, with any amount of aging, a cheddar has to be good to start with. Western pride in a cheddar, superior in all degrees of aging, runs high in that produced in Oregon's Tillamook Valley by the master craftsmen using the same painstaking skills brought over from cheddar's native England.

RAM-N-CHEESEWICHES

For each sandwich, spread two slices of bread with butter, mayonnaise or salad dressing. Cover each with a slice of mild-aged cheddar and a slice of baked or boiled ham. Top with a bread slice spread with butter or dressing and prepared mustard. Toast both sides under the broiler until golden brown, or pan-fry in butter over moderate heat. Serve hot. P.S. to mother: These sandwiches may be dipped in an egg and milk mixture and prepared as for French toast. This makes a good lunch-on-dish for all ages. Serve with garden-fresh lettuce or coleslaw.

SOME LIKE IT SHARP

All fruits, both fresh and preserved, go well with well-aged cheddar. Ripe pears, grapes, apples, kumquats, dates, figs are perfect partners. Crisp crackers in variety "belong." Note—serve this cheddar at room temperature always.

Serve apple, cherry, gooseberry, mince pies with generous chunks of well-aged cheddar. Or place a slice of the cheese on each wedge of warm pie, slipping the pieces under the broiler for a few minutes just before serving, so that the cheese starts to melt. Or top warm apple or mince pie with a spoonful of your favorite Welsh Rabbit, made with this sharp well-aged cheddar, of course.

CREAMED SALMON

1 1/2 teaspoons instant minced onion, 2 tablespoons cream, 1 tablespoon butter or margarine, 1/4 cup chopped celery, 1/4 cup sifted all-purpose flour, 2 cups rich milk, 1 tablespoon fresh lemon juice, 1 teaspoon salt, 1 cup flaked smoked salmon or cod (about 1/2 pound), 1 tablespoon chopped parsley, 1/2 cup toasted almonds (sliced, halves or whole), 4 patty shells, toast cups or corn bread squares, lemon wedges.

Ripe olives. Measure instant minced onion into water (omit water if raw onion is used). Melt butter, add onion and celery, and cook until soft but not browned. Add flour. Stir in milk; cook and stir until mixture thickens and is smooth. Add lemon juice, salt and salmon. Heat a few minutes longer. Add lemon juice, toast cups, or over squares of hot corn bread. Garnish with lemon wedges and ripe olives. Makes four servings.

FOR LENTEN DISHES

Shopping by telephone may be easier, but it takes a little time to get the variety in the menu if you don't tour the stores pretty often for food suggestions.

Ellis Landrum, Safeway Stores manager, has arranged a covered wagon display of Lenten season food suggestions to suggest a variety for Lenten menus at the Safeway Store on South Sixth.

We suggest an easy recipe for sauce to serve on the regular Friday fish. In between the times you wish to serve broiled or baked fish, try salmon or tuna loaf, tuna casseroles, minced clam soufflé or steamed shrimp over fluffy rice. For a change, make the sauce for the shrimp with canned tomato sauce, much as you would prepare the sauce for Spanish Rice.

FISH SAUCE

For the basic sauce recipe making two cups of sauce:

2 cups boiling water
1/2 cup instant nonfat dry milk powder
6 tablespoons flour
1 1/2 teaspoons salt
1/2 teaspoon pepper

Dissolve bouillon cube in boiling water in top of double boiler; cool slightly. Sprinkle remaining ingredients over surface. Beat with rotary beater until blended. Cook over hot water, stirring constantly, until thickened. Any of the following variations may be added to the basic sauce. Serve over baked whole fish or fish fillets.

Variations: Add 1/2 cup finely diced cucumber and 1 tablespoon minced onion.
Or, 1/2 cup finely chopped fresh dill and 1/2 teaspoon tarragon.
Or, 1/4 cup finely chopped chives if you can find them under the snow which covered our gardens earlier this week.
Or, two tablespoons capers and two tablespoons diced pimiento.

Creamed Salmon

Interesting new fish dishes are always in demand. Creamed Salmon offers a pleasing variety to vary Lenten menus. Richly-flavored smoked salmon, or cod, combines nicely with the well-seasoned sauce. Spoon into crisp patty shells, toast cups or over squares of golden corn bread. Send each serving to the table with tangy lemon wedges and glossy ripe olives.

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BEET BORSCHT

Beet Borscht is generally known as the soup of the Polish people. It is a hearty, nourishing soup that doesn't let that disservice you from preparing it. Your family will be more than a little impressed. The rosy color of the soup is fascinating but is likely to fade a bit unless the liquid from the beets is added to the soup. The beets, together with full-bodied California Claret wine is added just before the soup is served. It's really dreamy. More so, when room temperature California Claret accompanies the meal.

BEET BORSCHT

2 tablespoons butter
1/2 cup finely-chopped carrots
1/2 cup shredded cabbage
1/2 cup finely-chopped celery
2 1/2 cups water
2 tablespoons instant minced onion or 1/4 cup finely-chopped raw onion
4 bouillon cubes
1 (1-pound) can beets
1 1/2 tablespoons sugar
1/2 teaspoon salt
2 to 4 tablespoons wine vinegar
1/4 cup California Claret, or other red table wine
Commercial sour cream

Melt butter in a large pot. Add carrots, cabbage and onion. Cook 10 minutes over low heat, or until vegetables are tender but slightly crisp. Add water, onion and bouillon cubes; heat until mixture simmers and bouillon cubes dissolve. Drain liquid from beets and reserve. Dice beets; add to soup mixture. Add sugar, salt and 1/2 tablespoon of wine vinegar. (Taste and add more wine vinegar, if desired.) Just before serving, add liquid from beets and wine. Top each serving with sour cream. Makes about 1 quart (3 to 4 servings).
