

### Council Sets Dump Study

DORRIS — As the present Dorris city dump has been declared inadequate, the Dorris City Council decided at its March 3 meeting to investigate the establishment of a larger, more suitable dump site.

Scott Waisner, candidate for a seat on the council, appeared before the council and requested the council look into the city garbage dump problem. Waisner pointed out that the dump is open and should be closed for sanitary reasons. He also proposed that the council consider establishing a garbage route and grant a franchise to haul garbage, and to keep the dump closed.

Mayor Bob Edgar pointed out

that the state law requires a closed dump.

Two building applications were approved by the council. A permit was granted to Jack Fleming for a two car garage, and another one to Archie Brimmer for repairs on the former Pastega house at Fourth and Seattle streets.

The council also approved a request from Copco to move over-weight loads through Railroad Avenue and First Street. The post office was given permission to install a mail box in front of the post office.

Virginia Hamilton, city clerk, was authorized to transfer \$1,000 from the water fund to the fire department equipment fund.

### KF Concert Schedule Told

An outstanding and varied program of concerts for the 1958-59 season was announced Monday by Andrew Loney Jr., president of the Klamath Community Concert Association.

The organization closed its membership ranks Saturday with more than 1,200 on its rolls; then the board and talent selection committee met and named the following artists for next season's concert series: Albert da Costa, tenor; the San Francisco Operatic Quartet, the Chicago Opera Ballet and Gold and Fisdale, duo-pianists.

The Chicago Opera Ballet, to be presented Thursday, February 19, includes a company of 50, with internationally famous ballet stars, a corps de ballet, and orchestra. The group returns to Klamath Falls for the second time in three years by popular demand.

Da Costa is a leading member of the Metropolitan Opera and is described as possessing "one of the most beautiful voices one could wish to hear." He has also performed with the Berkshire Festival

and with New York's American Opera Society. Recently he appeared seven times at London's Covent Garden in "Aida."

The San Francisco Operatic Quartet, under the direction of its founder, Maestro Nino Cornel, is composed of Nancy Cornburt, soprano; Margot Blum, contralto; Jess Thomas, tenor and Ronald Duiro, baritone. The group gives audiences an opportunity to hear seldom performed operatic masterpieces, in addition to the standard repertoire.

Leading the duo-piano field in premiering or discovering new or hitherto unknown works, Gold and Fisdale recently discovered

two Mendelssohn concertos for two pianos (A flat and E major). They are completing premiere performances in Italy, France, Holland and with the New York Philharmonic.






