the library art show. As librarian William R. Holman declares: "A public library must create an opportunity for today's family to experience together the finest in music, art, ideas, and the printed word."

For the library worker, of course, this presents a tremendous challenge. Writing in the *Library Journal*, Shirley Miller, librarian of South Junior High School in Kalamazoo, Mich., said, "The modern librarian must have at least a nodding acquaintance with every major phase of human endeavor . . . a smattering of science is necessary . . . she must be as well-informed on current events as any news analyst . . . she is expected to be a psychologist . . . she may be asked for a story that will help a boy face his father's alcoholism or books that will help immigrants to understand their new homeland . . ."

Needless to say, a good library—and intelligent librarians—can have tremendous influence in shaping young and curious minds. When Ernest Hemingway won the Nobel Prize for literature in 1954, he sent \$100 to the Oak Park (Ill.) Public Library where he had spent many an hour as a boy.

It was Ralph Waldo Emerson who once likened a library to "a sort of harem." With all the many "extras" being offered today, the public library has become a veritable palace of pleasure!
