

Spiritual Strength Stressed On Armed Forces Day

Prisoners' Decisions For Christ Overwhelm Graham

SAN FRANCISCO (UP)—Evangelist Billy Graham declared today he was "overwhelmed" at the number of San Quentin prison convicts who made "decisions for Christ" at a sermon he preached there.

"I'm inviting you all to attend our crusade meeting tonight at the Cow Palace — if you can make it," he said.

Four thousand convicts sprawled in the hot sunshine on the baseball field Thursday to listen to Graham's sermon. At the end, 623 came forward to "live for God in prison."

After the service, hundreds of inmates crowded around Graham, asking him to sign autographs. After signing about 25 autographs, Graham said:

"It takes great courage for men to step out and witness for God in these surroundings," Graham said.

"I can sign any more. I haven't any more time." "Oh, we've got lots of time," the inmates chorused.

He turned over their pledge cards to the prison chaplain, who will get in touch with the men to give them further spiritual guidance.

Later, Graham visited death row and spoke to 18 of its 21 condemned men. Author-convict Carl Chessman remained in his cell. Prison spokesmen said the 18 "greatly appreciated" Graham's visit.
