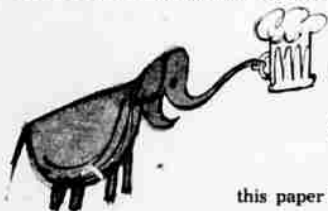


# Nonsense, U.S.A.

But the skin of the thing that made her go."



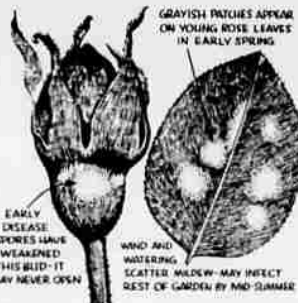
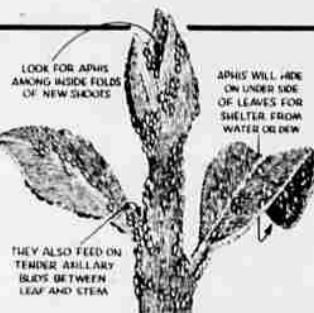
