## BRIDAL SHOWER

By now most June brides have done a lot of planning for the wedding. And, if you're planning to have a bride-to-be with a shower, you probably are making some advance preparations, too.

A shower for the bride-to-be calls for special refreshments not necessarily the party foods that take long preparation, but attractive, good tasting refreshments to make the occasion more festive.

Cake and punch are easy-to-fix party foods to serve at a bridal shower. The cake can be made in advance, while the punch needs only mixing at serving time.

### BRIDAL SHOWER CAKE

A heart-shaped cake is festive for the shower. The light, delicate flavor of the filled cake in the following recipe is especially good with a fruit punch. This light-textured cake is out of the ordinary in that it is made with a bottle of lemon-lime carbonated beverage (7-Up), with flavor derived from natural oils of lemons and limes, the beverage lends a hint of fruit flavor to the cake.

Use the egg yolks remaining from the cake for the zesty filling. Frost with a favorite "seven-minute" icing, tinted in a delicate shade of the wedding color scheme.

### LEMON-LIME HEART CAKE

1/2 cup butter or margarine  
1 cup sugar  
2 1/2 cups sifted cake flour  
2 1/2 teaspoons baking powder  
1/2 teaspoon salt  
1 7-ounce bottle lemon-lime carbonated beverage (7-Up)  
3 egg whites, beaten stiff

Cream butter and sugar until fluffy. Sift flour with baking powder and salt and stir into mixture alternately with lemon-lime carbonated beverage. Fold in beaten egg whites carefully. Pour batter into greased heart-shaped baking pans. (Or, use 8-inch round layer cake pans and trim edges to a heart shape after baking.) Bake at 35 degrees 30 to 35 minutes. Cool on cake racks and remove from pans. Cut layers in half lengthwise to make four layers and spread with filling.

### FILLING

1/2 cup flour  
1 cup sugar  
1 7-ounce bottle lemon-lime carbonated beverage (7-Up)  
3 egg yolks, slightly beaten  
1 tablespoon butter or margarine

Blend flour with sugar in saucepan, stir in lemon-lime carbonated beverage and cook over medium heat, stirring constantly, until mixture thickens and comes to a boil. Add some of hot mixture to yolks, stir well, and return to pan, cooking and stirring two minutes. Stir in butter, cool slightly and spread between cake layers. Frost cake with a fluffy icing.

### SPARKLING FRUIT PUNCH

An easy punch to serve at the shower is a simple combination of a fruit juice and carbonated beverage. Chill the juice and beverage in advance and, at serving time, combine equal parts of beverage with juice. One refreshing combination is six 7-ounce bottles lemon-lime carbonated beverage (7-Up) and one 46-ounce can orange juice to make about 24 punch cups. Garnish the cups with orange slices if you like.

### POT ROAST

Rub the pot roast (after wiping it with a damp cloth) with flour mixed with salt and pepper. Use the leftover flour mixture for thickening for gravy.



**REFRESHMENTS** for a bridal shower should be attractive, yet easy to prepare. This heart-shaped cake with its delicious lemon-lime filling, can be prepared a day in advance. The punch is a simple combination of orange juice and lemon-lime carbonated beverage (7-Up).

**PERFECTION SALAD** is a perfect setup for a summer supper. This can be a real relaxer for the cook since everything can be made ahead of time and chilled until ready to serve. Cold meats (such as meat loaf) for sandwiches, salad and a cold beverage (such as iced Maxwell House Instant Coffee) and you've got it made. It is an ideal salad for this week because finely chopped pickles make it a fitting National Pickle Week observance.

## COOL MOLDED SALAD

Shredded cabbage (and it is excellent right now), diced celery and grated carrot add nice fresh vegetables to this molded salad. However, the addition of finely chopped pickle chips or sweet pickles adds the final touch of elegant flavor. We have found so many persons don't care for green pepper, but we don't know anybody who doesn't like pickles of one variety or another.

Serve a dish of pickles on the side—after all, this is National Pickle Week.

The base of this creamy salad combines evaporated milk with lemon flavored gelatin. If you really want to get ahead of the game, you can make a meat loaf in the morning while you're making the salad and your sandwich meat will be all ready for the evening meal.

1 cup finely shredded cabbage  
1 cup diced celery  
1 cup shredded raw carrot  
1/4 cup chopped pickles  
1/2 teaspoon grated onion

Place gelatin in a medium size mixing bowl. Add boiling water and stir until gelatin is dissolved. Cool, then stir in evaporated milk gradually. Add salt and dry mustard to vinegar, mix well, then add to the gelatin mixture slowly while stirring. (Mixture may look curdled, but this does not affect appearance of finished salad.)

Chill gelatin mixture until it begins to gel. Fold in vegetables. Spoon into a quart mold. Chill until set, about three hours.

Makes six to eight servings.

### PERFECTION SALAD

1 package lemon flavored gelatin  
1 cup boiling water  
1 cup evaporated milk  
1/2 teaspoon salt  
1/4 teaspoon dry mustard  
1/4 cup vinegar
