QUICK PIE

CHOCOLATE-CINNAMON CHIFFON PIE

1 package chocolate chiffon pie filling mix
1 cup boiling hot milk (x)
1/4 cup sugar
1/4 teaspoon cinnamon
1 baked 9-inch pie shell, cooled
(x Homogenized or skim milk recommended.)

Place pie filling mix in a small deep mixing bowl (about 1 1/2 quart size). Add boiling hot milk. Mix well. Beat vigorously with rotary beater or at highest speed of electric mixer, until filling stands in peaks, about three to six minutes. Add sugar and cinnamon; beat one minute. Pour into pie shell. Chill until set, about two hours. Serve plain or garnish with whipped cream and additional cinnamon.

Note: Store leftover pie in refrigerator covered with an inverted pie pan.

Carrier Set For Junk Pile

WASHINGTON (AP)—Navy Secretary Thomas S. Gates has signed the final papers that will send to the junk heap the carrier Enterprise, battleship veteran of World War II.

The Navy action Tuesday, which will put the "Big E" up for auction as scrap, followed the failure of private individuals and Pacific war veterans, headed by Fleet Adm. William F. Halsey, to raise enough money to preserve the Fighting Lady as a permanent memorial.

The Navy was informed late last month that the Enterprise fund drive had been halted after collection of about \$100,000, far short of the million dollars required. The fund raisers told the Navy they wanted the \$100,000 donated to the Navy-Marine memorial stadium which will be built at Annapolis, Md.

The Enterprise was placed in the reserve fleet some years ago. But with the modernization of later and larger carriers and the building of much bigger ones, it was removed from the active list and several years ago the Navy suggested that money might be saved on her upkeep in the mothball fleet by disposing of the ship for scrap.

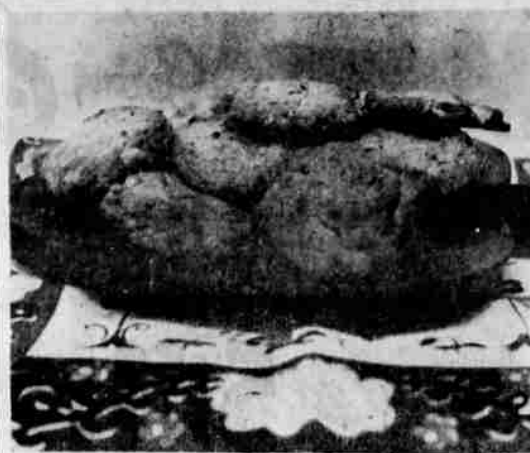
ADVICE FOR CLERGYMEN
