

Reuther Steps In Personally At Chrysler

DETROIT (AP) — United Auto Workers President Walter Reuther today assumed personal command of negotiations with Chrysler Corp., storm center of the UAW's efforts to reach contract agreement with the automotive Big Three.

Reuther's surprise decision came yesterday, less than three hours after Chrysler sent 2,000 workers home early from its Jefferson-Kearney plant in another of a series of incidents which have marked the no-contract period.

Norman Matthews, director of the UAW's Chrysler department, said Chrysler was trying to provoke the 75,000 Chrysler workers into a strike. He urged the UAW members to stay on the job at all costs.

Chrysler officials said they were not trying to disrupt the union. They said, however, that workers will have to keep up production and efficiency.

Chrysler said the early closing of the Jefferson-Kearney plant yesterday was due to "a temporary adjustment in scheduling production."

But Jack Widlick, chairman of the UAW chief stewards' committee at the two plants, claimed company officials told him the workers were sent home because of "poor workmanship."

Negotiations between Chrysler and the UAW resumed today after a one day interruption. Ford and GM also met with the union after reporting no progress in talks yesterday.

Meanwhile, the UAW said Ford locals at the Mercury plant in St. Louis and the Ford assembly plant in Chicago have voted to approve a strike in support of union contract demands.

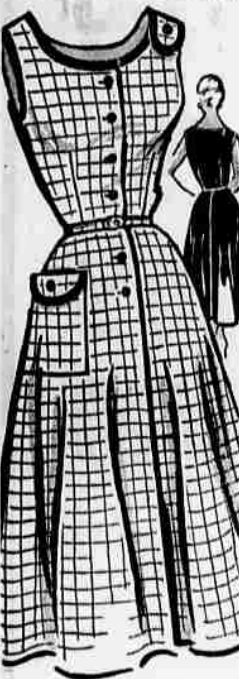
UAW locals at Ford and GM plants in Cleveland were reported planning to take similar votes on Sunday.

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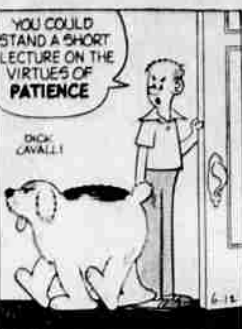

Police Exam Given Here

A written examination for lieutenant in the Klamath Falls Police Department was given Tuesday in the council chambers.

Ten officers, all on the local force, took the test, composed of 100 questions relating to police work. It required three hours. Police Judge Frank Blackmer monitored the exams.

The papers have been sent to Salem where they will be graded by the State Civil Service Commission.

All applicants who receive a passing grade of 70 per cent or higher will be eligible to take the oral tests on June 26. The oral will count 40 per cent, the written, 60 per cent.

Conducting the oral examination will be Salem Police Chief Clyde Warren and an aide.

The most qualified applicant will be selected after these tests to fill the job, recommended by a recent survey of the police department.

Space Board Plan Studied

WASHINGTON (AP) — Senate Republican Leader William F. Knowland of California said today he believes President Eisenhower would accept a board-controlled civilian space agency.

Rejecting White House requests for a single director for the new space agency, the Senate Space Committee approved its own version yesterday. This would provide for a seven-member board to control the new agency's policies.

Democratic Leader Lyndon B. Johnson of Texas, who heads the special Space Committee, told newsmen he had not discussed the change with the White House or with leaders in the House, which previously had approved the single director idea.

Johnson said the modified Senate plan assured civilian dominance over the military in the new space era.

Giveaway Program Comes Back To Merchandising

NEW YORK (UPI) — Watch out, Santa Claus. On your guard, Gen. Trujillo Jr.

When it comes to handing out free gifts, retailers across the United States can give you both competition.

A United Press International survey reveals that many merchants are going in for some old-fashioned showmanship and new-fangled gimmicks to woo the consumer and stimulate sales.

They're giving away stockings and subway rides, Cadillacs and cabin cruisers, ladders and lubrication, and just plain money.

Perhaps the most intriguing sales gimmick came up last week when the New York City Transit Authority announced a plan to let subway and bus riders get free rides for certain soap coupons. Three coupons equal one free ride.

This offer came shortly after manufacturers of jet airliners said they'll arrange for trade-ins on piston-powered jets such as Boeing Stratocruisers and DC7s.

Not to be outdone, a New York appliance dealer offered to swap television sets and appliances for odd lot shares of stock. He'll pay the cost of the stock transfer.

Automobile dealers also show the effects of the giveaway itch. A car dealer in Detroit offers buyers free lubrication service for the life of the car. Another auto dealer in Langhorne, Pa., duplicates this offer and throws in a free dinner for two. A lucky customer in Dallas bought a new car and also received a boat, outboard motor and boat trailer for free.

A paint store in Dallas gives away a free ladder to those who purchase enough paint to cover the house.

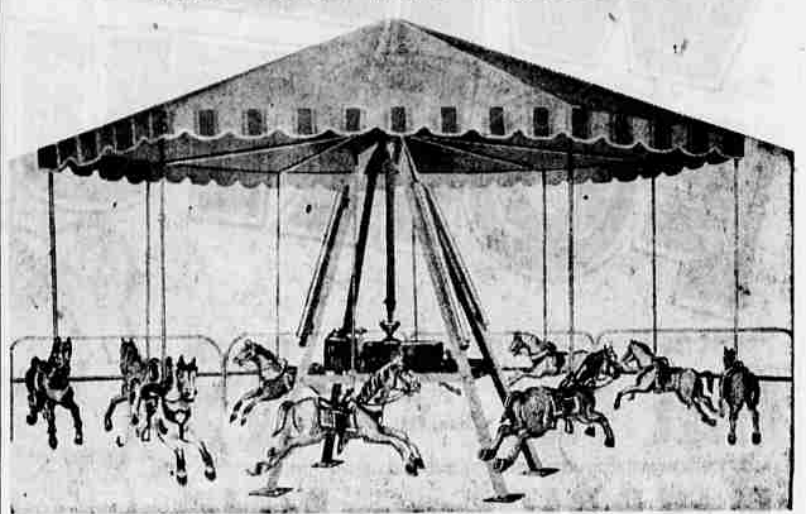
