CHILOQUIN—Mr. and Mrs. Warren O. Nowowiejski, missionaries to Colombia, South America, will be the guest speakers at the Assembly of God Church Sunday, June 15. Rev. William Rentz announced today. They will relate some of their experiences and tell of the progress of missions in Colombia, which have grown in spite of the political unrest.

It was in 1949 that Nowowiejski first went to Colombia. He returned to the states in 1952. He was married and with his wife returned to Colombia for four and one-half years, where they taught in the day school and Bible school in Sogamoso, Boyaca. He was vice president of the Colombia Assemblies of God and director of the Bible School for two years.

After their furlough the Nowowiejskis plan to return to South America. Rev. Rentz extends a cordial invitation to the public to hear the talks which will begin at 7:30 at 7:30.
