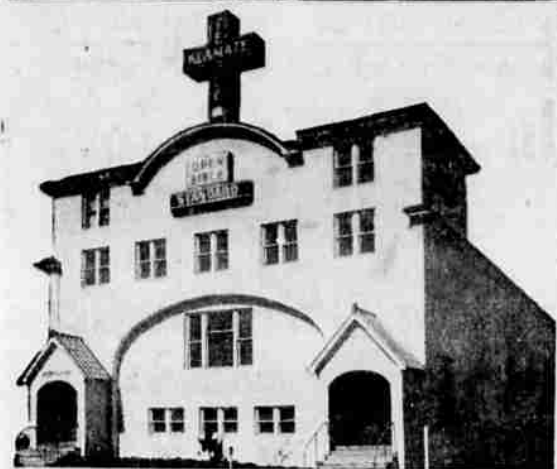

pel work were held in the former Orpheus Theater at 1128 Main Street. There were 32 charter members. The original frame church building at Eighth and Oak streets was dedicated in January 1926.

Under Dr. Miller's ministry the church grew. The late F. Ellsworth Pellet organized an orchestra with instruments furnished by the church. A women's missionary circle was started and Aimee Somple McPherson held meetings for the Temple at the fairgrounds exhibit building.

The congregation met in the basement started for a larger sanctuary for a time, and work was begun on the new first floor. The church was continuing to expand. The radio program over KFJJ which is still heard every Sunday was started and the young people's group had some 70 members.

In August 1933, fire destroyed the entire structure and the congregation went back to worship services in a tent. The rebuilt church was dedicated in 1934 at 1007 Pine Street, its present location. The church joined fellowship with the Open Bible Standard organization; an annex was built and a console organ installed.

Rev. Keith L. Hume came to the pastorate in August 1953 and during his ministry new robes for the 30-voice choir were purchased, the platform was enlarged, a new pulpit installed and wall to wall carpeting was laid.

Rev. Strachan accepted the pastorate in September 1955.

The church was organized in the spring and summer of 1925 through the efforts of Mrs. Bell Kidwell, Klamath Falls and Dr. B. C. Miller, then pastor of the First Baptist Church of Ashland who later became the church's first pastor.

The first evangelist conducted services in an excavation at Klamath Avenue and Eighth where the Pelican Theater now stands. Later that fall other evangelistic services were held in a tent warmed by wood burning stoves.
