TV NOTES

NEW YORK (UPI) — During the summer NBC is turning its every-other-Saturday "Club Oasis" spot over to Spike Jones and his orchestra. Live from The Burbank, California, studios.

Still another quiz show headed for CBS exposure is "Play Your Hunch," starting June 30 on a Monday-through-Friday basis, 10-10:30 a.m. Singer Merv Griffin will be a master of ceremonies. This show provides for participation for prizes by home viewers. Two husband-wife teams will be contestants in the studio. It is a guessing game based on intuition.

The last "Climax!" play on CBS will be June 26. The series is dead after that. It will be replaced beginning July 3 by the new one-hour nighttime version of "The Verdict Is Yours," currently a five-a-week afternoon half-hour show.

"Have Gun, Will Travel" goes on summer repeats for CBS on June 21.

CBS reports it has captured London's Old Vic Company for a 90-minute version of "Hamlet" for presentation early in 1959. It will be one of the "Du Pont Show of the Month" series. The troupe will be on tour in this country at the time.

A new half-hour filmed series just placed on the market by NBC's syndicate division is "Danger Is My Business," a documentary based on perilous occupations.

The last "Climax!" program on CBS will be June 26. Not just the last of the season either—this live one-hour show has been jettisoned.

William Leicester gets two-way credits in television. He's both actor and author. His latest acting chore was on "Goodyear Theater" as the menace in a play called "Decision by Terror." He has 34 TV scripts to his credit, including 39 for "Tales of Wells Fargo."

"The Restless Gun" will remain on the summer NBC schedule Monday nights through the repeating of 13 episodes, June 23 through September 15.

"Zane Grey Theater" June 27 will have an episode in which the leading actress is Anne Bancroft, current toast of the New York stage because of her work in "Two for the Seesaw." This half-hour film was her last work for the cameras before going into the Broadway play.
