MOVIES - TELEVISION

PARIS (NEA) — The biggest laugh in Paris?

Pardon my French film friends, but it's Brigitte Bardot. The zippy miss, they say, just can't have that much sex appeal in the U.S. and they wish someone with Champs-Elysees chic instead of raw Montmartre wallp could be France's best-known cinematic export.

"How does she stay alive?" they chuckle. "Nevarr does she exhale."

It's sour grapes, of course and '58, I'm sure, will be known as a bad vintage year for French champagne. But it's a great year for Brigitte, who is making movies here faster than American tourists spend money.

A couple of newsmen spoke briefly to Miss Double B in her Studio de Boulogne dressing room before my arrival, but after that she went into a Garbo act, even refusing to speak to her French newspaper pals. A collection of excuses to various newsmen, foreign and domestic, included:

"A bad case of acne she's embarrassed about and I was told she had a fractured jaw suffered in a fall. But the Paris grapevine was twisting with reports that it wasn't a fall. Maybe someone will have solved the Bardot mystery by the time you read this."

The sudden film discovery of Brigitte's 19-year-old sister, Mijanou, has left BB with an off-the-screen pool that has nothing to do with her on-screen pool. The Mijanou line isn't dedicated, I hear, to protecting Brigitte, who

is worried about little sister overshadowing her. Mijanou casts quite a shadow, too.

Marilyn Monroe's two and three-hour lateness keeping appointments, they say here, has inspired Brigitte's sometimes days-late slaughter of other people's time. But her associates just shrug their shoulders and wait, saying:

"Amour."
Orson Welles, the fellow who moves around the world like a SAC pilot, is home in Paris, he says. But the Champs-Elysees and the Avenue George V, he bellows for all to hear, "should be out of bounds to American tourists so they'll really see Paris."

Orson, I've discovered, is the only big bargain in Paris this summer. Only for Darryl Zanuck, that is. Darryl is paying him absolutely nothing for playing a TV commentator in "The Roots of Heaven." Orson is doing the role as a debt of gratitude for a past Zanuck favor which enabled him to complete his "Othello" movie.

"The Long Hot Summer" brought the one-time Man from Mars into orbit with Joanne Woodward and Paul Newman, new products of the New York Group Theater acting school.

"And as people," Orson told me, "I liked them. But I can't agree with their acting theories. It would take me 7,000 words to tell you why, but let's just say that I don't believe anyone should study acting to be an actor. I believe a young person should study

everything except acting.

"I don't think acting should be a public exhibition of private neurosis."

On the Welles work schedule after "The Roots of Heaven:" Completing "Don Quixote," which he filmed in Mexico with himself, Patty McCormack and Akin Tamiroff, and a series of ABC documentary telefilms he's making in Italy. The first is "The Gina Lollobrigida Story," a la "Jimmy Dean Story."
