

First Commercial Jet Airliner Due To Take To Skies About November 1

NEW YORK (UPI)—The great multi-billion-dollar jet era, heralded as the greatest transportation development since the change from sail to steam, will begin with the roar of a giant vacuum cleaner.

A lumbering machine will roll down a New York Idlewild International Airport runway picking up rocks and other particles that could gum up the works of a jet engine.

Then a big swept-wing jet plane will suddenly sprint down the airstrip, vault into the air and in 29 minutes be cruising at 29,000 feet over Nantucket Island.

This will be Pan American World Airways jet Flight No. 1, leaving Idlewild at 11 p.m. e.s.t., on or about Nov. 1, bound for Paris with 140 passengers and a crew of 8.

It will be the nation's first commercial jet flight, ushering in an age that has been in the making since World War II, at a cost of billions to airlines, airports and local, state and federal governments.

Pan American's tentative inaugural flight plan calls for cruising at altitudes ranging from 30,000 to 40,000 feet at a speed of nearly 600 miles an hour. In a little more than seven hours, the passengers will be strolling on the Champs Elysees.

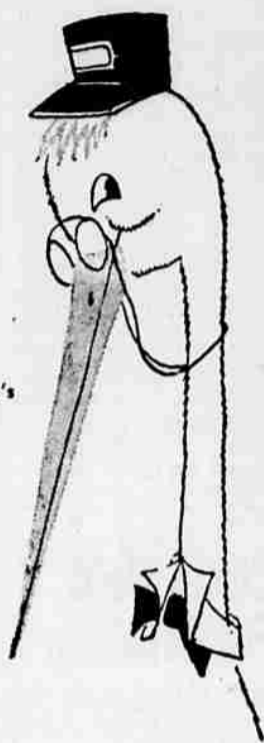
Other planes and other airlines will follow this single jet into the stiff competition for passengers.

Finally, by 1961, a total of about 230 U.S. operated jet planes, capable of carrying up to 150 passengers each, and nearly 200 smaller prop jets will be plying the skies. Foreign airlines will add heavily to the maze of frosty white jet trails streaking the world's skies.

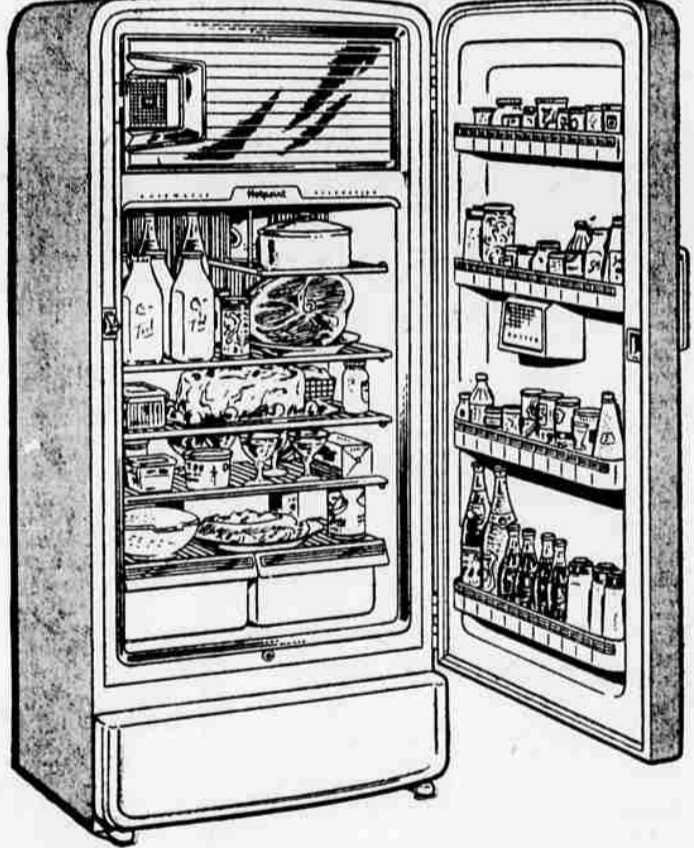
