4 Youths To Wartime Adventure Book Attend Camp Points Up Power Of Faith

Four Klamath County boys will be chosen to attend a wartime adventure book camp which will be held in Lake County the first week in August, with all expenses paid. This announcement was made by Walter Risse, the county committeeman chosen by the Pacific Northwest Section of the American Society of Range Management to help in picking out boys from this county, and to help in raising scholarships to send the boys.

Two boys will be chosen on the basis of their range plan and range management knowledge, and the other two will be chosen because of outstanding citizenship and leadership. Boys must be between 14 and 17 years of age, inclusive. Subjects taught at the camp include identification of plants, use of hunting and fishing equipment, how to get along in the woods, what to do if lost, and problems involved in managing ranges, both open rangeland and forest. A number of contests are run at the camp in finding and naming plants that grow in the camp area.

Sponsors in Klamath County last year sent two boys to the camp. Candidates for selection on the basis of range knowledge will be open to all 4-H and FFA boys. A local committee has been formed to help pick boys eligible because of leadership or citizenship.

The committee, which consists of Charles Street, Francis Skinn, D. K. Frewing, Carroll Howe, James D. Harpole, Ray Peterson, and representatives of the Klamath Men's Association and of Klamath Union High School, will meet Thursday morning at 9 o'clock at the U.S. Forest Service office in the Post Office Building. Anyone having candidates to propose may attend the meeting.

Man Sentenced For Speeding

LONDON (AP) — Moscow Radio reported Tuesday that U. S. conductor Leopold Stokowski's first concert in Leningrad was a great success. Stokowski led the Leningrad Philharmonic, Russia's leading symphony orchestra, in a program Monday night which included a transcription of a Bach Fugue, the prelude and love death from Wagner's "Tristan and Isolde" and Shostakovich's 11th symphony.
