The First Baptist Church, Klamath Falls, observed the first graduation service in the history of the church on Sunday night, June 22. Thirteen persons received diplomas presented for achievements in the Sunday School training course, sponsored by the Southern Baptist Convention.

Group Tells Meeting Plan

Jehovah's Witnesses from the Klamath Falls congregation, announce that plans are under way to attend an international convention of Jehovah's Witnesses in New York city this summer.

George Hriciszec, presiding minister of the local group, said the convention is expected to be the largest in the history of Jehovah's Witnesses. It is scheduled for July 27 through August 3 and will be held in Yankee Stadium and the Polo Grounds simultaneously.

The last international convention, attended by many Klamath Falls members, was held in 1953 in Yankee Stadium and reached a peak attendance of 165,000 including the overflow audiences. Watchtower officials, Hriciszec said, have arranged this year for the program to be held in both places, with most program features repeated at the Polo Grounds immediately following the first presentation in Yankee Stadium.

The Watchtower Bible and Tract Society, governing agency for Jehovah's Witnesses, has been making special travel arrangements for foreign delegates. Many missionaries who have served in other lands will also be brought to the United States for the Bible convention. Purpose of the gathering is to provide stimulus for the New World Society of Jehovah's Witnesses in Christian association, Bible instruction and ministerial training. This, Hriciszec said, is in accordance with provisions made for God's people in Bible days.

Hriciszec stated that it is not yet known how many church members from the area will attend, but, he added, special travel arrangements are being made by plane, train, and bus. He said further, it may be necessary to make limited meeting arrangements or cancel local meetings altogether during convention time.

Rev. and Mrs. Harry M. Strachan, pastors of the Klamath Temple, have been in attendance at the 26th annual Convention Resolutions of the Open Bible Standard Churches, Inc., Des Moines, Iowa.

The organization has 50 adult missionaries in Cuba, Jamaica, French West Africa, Japan, Liberia, Trinidad. There are five Bible institutions in Des Moines, Eugene, Dayton, Ohio, St. Petersburg, Florida and Pasadena, with 55 churches and 800 ministers.

The pastor and Mrs. Strachan will be present for the June 29 Sunday service.
