TV Notes

NEW YORK (UPI)—A program of polka songs and dances has been set by ABC to bow June 23; Mondays from 9:30 to 10:30 p.m. It will originate in the network's WBKB station in Chicago. There will be a studio audience seated "in the round," completely encircling the action and within camera range at all times. "Polka-go-Round," as it is called, takes over the spot occupied regularly by "Lawrence Welk's Top Tunes and New Talent," which will return to the air August 25.

"Robin Hood" will be back for a fourth season on CBS. In fact, the network itself has now bought this English-made property. Official Films also will offer the old episodes for syndicated "strip programming" that will not conflict with the new network product.

Actress Betsy Palmer, who has been on "I've Got a Secret" so many times, finally has been designated as one of the four permanent panelists, replacing Faye Emerson.

Here's a program, not for next season but for the next, next season, 1959-60. "Father of the Bride" is the title of the situation comedy series, and, as the title would indicate, is based on Edward Streeter's popular novel which became a very successful movie for MGM back in 1950. A five-year contract is involved in the TV deal by an advertising agency for one of its clients.

July 5 will mark the start of the fourth year of "The Lawrence Welk Show" on ABC, a summer replacement program that quickly became so popular that it has been on year-round ever since.
